RURAL LANDS PROTECTION ACT 1998

ORDER UNDER PART 11 IN RESPECT OF SPUR-THROATED LOCUST

PEST CONTROL ORDER NUMBER 5

I, Richard Amery, Minister for Agriculture make this order pursuant to Part 11 of the *Rural Lands Protection Act 1998*.

1. This order applies to all land in rural lands protection districts set out in Schedule 1.
2. In this order **Spur-Throated Locust** means any insect of the species *Austracis guttulosa*.
3. I declare, pursuant to Section 143(1), the Spur-Throated Locust to be a pest.
4. I impose, pursuant to Section 143(2)(a), a **general destruction obligation** requiring the occupier of controlled land to eradicate the pest by any lawful method.
5. I impose, pursuant to Section 143(2)(c), a **notification obligation** requiring the occupier of controlled land to give the board for the district in which the controlled land is situated to provide notice of the presence of the Spur-Throated Locust on the land as soon as practical after becoming aware of its presence.
6. I empower, pursuant to Section 143(2)(d), all boards in New South Wales to serve an **individual eradication order** requiring the occupier or owner (other than a public authority) of controlled land in its district requiring the occupier or owner to eradicate the pest by use of a method specified by the board in the order.
7. I empower, pursuant to Section 143(2)(e), a board to publish a **general eradication order** in accordance with this Part requiring all occupiers of land within its district (or a specified part of its district) to eradicate the pest by use of a method specified by the board in the order.
8. I confer, pursuant to Section 143(2)(f), power on all authorised officers who are rangers and all authorised officers appointed for the purposes of Part 11 to take measures to carry out work on controlled land to eradicate the pest.
9. I specify pursuant to section 143(7)(a), that, in respect of the exercise of the power under section 143(2)(f) by authorised officers on land under the care, control and management of the National Parks and Wildlife Service, that such power cannot be exercised unless and until the written approval of the Director-General of National Parks and Wildlife has been obtained.
10. I require, pursuant to Section 143(2)(j), a board to supply materials that have been provided to it for the eradication of the pest on controlled land within its district, free of charge, to the owner or occupier of the land.
11. I specify, pursuant to section 143(3), that a person may use a method of eradication approved for the purpose of controlling the pest under the *Pesticides Act 1999* which involves the application of the substance or thing from the air in the execution of the person's obligations under this order.
12. This order has effect for a period of 5 years.

RURAL LANDS PROTECTION ACT 1998
ORDER UNDER PART 11 IN RESPECT OF AUSTRALIAN PLAGUE LOCUST
PEST CONTROL ORDER NUMBER 6

I, Richard Amery, Minister for Agriculture make this order pursuant to Part 11 of the *Rural Lands Protection Act 1998*.

1. This order applies to all land in rural lands protection districts set out in Schedule 1.
2. In this order **Australian Plague Locust** means any insect of the species *Chortoices terminifera*.
3. I declare, pursuant to Section 143(1), the Australian Plague Locust to be a pest.
4. I impose, pursuant to Section 143(2)(a), a **general destruction obligation** requiring the occupier of controlled land to eradicate the pest by any lawful method.
5. I impose, pursuant to Section 143(2)(c), a **notification obligation** requiring the occupier of controlled land to give the board for the district in which the controlled land is situated to provide notice of the presence of the Australian Plague Locust on the land as soon as practical after becoming aware of its presence.
6. I empower, pursuant to Section 143(2)(d), all boards in New South Wales to serve an **individual eradication order** requiring the occupier or owner (other than a public authority) of controlled land in its district requiring the occupier or owner to eradicate the pest by use of a method specified by the board in the order.
7. I empower, pursuant to Section 143(2)(e), a board to publish a **general eradication order** in accordance with this Part requiring all occupiers of land within its district (or a specified part of its district) to eradicate the pest by use of a method specified by the board in the order.
8. I confer, pursuant to Section 143(2)(f), power on all authorised officers who are rangers and all authorised officers appointed for the purposes of Part 11 to take measures to carry out work on controlled land to eradicate the pest.
9. I specify pursuant to section 143(7)(a), that, in respect of the exercise of the power under section 143(2)(f) by authorised officers on land under the care, control and management of the National Parks and Wildlife Service, that such power cannot be exercised unless and until the written approval of the Director-General of National Parks and Wildlife has been obtained.
10. I require, pursuant to Section 143(2)(j) 'a board to supply materials that have been provided to it for the eradication of the pest on controlled land within its district, free of charge, to the owner or occupier of the land.
11. I specify, pursuant to section 143(3), that a person may use a method of eradication approved for the purpose of controlling the pest under the *Pesticides Act 1999* which involves the application of the substance or thing from the air in the execution of the person's obligations under this order.
12. This order is effective for a period of 5 years.

ORDER UNDER PART 11 IN RESPECT OF MIGRATORY LOCUST
PEST CONTROL ORDER NUMBER 7

I, Richard Amery, Minister for Agriculture make this order pursuant to Part 11 of the *Rural Lands Protection Act 1998*.

1. This order applies to all land in rural lands protection districts set out in Schedule 1.
2. In this order **Migratory Locust** means any insect of the species *Locusta migratoria*.
3. I declare, pursuant to Section 143(1), the Migratory Locust to be a pest.
4. I impose, pursuant to Section 143(2)(a), a **general destruction obligation** requiring the occupier of controlled land to eradicate the pest by any lawful method.
5. I impose, pursuant to Section 143(2)(c), a **notification obligation** requiring the occupier of controlled land to give the board for the district in which the controlled land is situated to provide notice of the presence of the Migratory Locust on the land as soon as practical after becoming aware of its presence.
6. I empower, pursuant to Section 143(2)(d), all boards in New South Wales to serve an **individual eradication order** requiring the occupier or owner (other than a public authority) of controlled land in its district requiring the occupier or owner to eradicate the pest by use of a method specified by the board in the order.
7. I empower, pursuant to Section 143(2)(e), a board to publish a **general eradication order** in accordance with this Part requiring all occupiers of land within its district (or a specified part of its district) to eradicate the pest by use of a method specified by the board in the order.
8. I confer, pursuant to Section 143(2)(f), power on all authorised officers who are rangers and all authorised officers appointed for the purposes of Part 11 to take measures to carry out work on controlled land to eradicate the pest.
9. I specify pursuant to section 143(7)(a), that, in respect of the exercise of the power under section 143(2)(f) by authorised officers on land under the care, control and management of the National Parks and Wildlife Service, that such power cannot be exercised unless and until the written approval of the Director-General of National Parks and Wildlife has been obtained.
