### FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994

Section 8 Notification – Fishing Closure

Coffs Creek and Park Beach (Coffs Harbour)

I, Richard Sheldrake, prohibit the taking of fish as specified in Column 1 of the Schedule of this notification, from waters shown opposite in Column 2 of the Schedule.

This prohibition is effective for a period of 60 days from the date of publication, unless sooner varied or revoked by notification of Deputy Director-General, Agriculture and Fisheries.

### SCHEDULE

Coffs Creek and Park Beach (Coffs Harbour) – All Methods

<i>Column 1</i> <b>Methods</b>	<i>Column 2</i> <b>Waters</b>
All <b>fish</b> by any method.	The whole of the waters of Coffs Creek to its upper tidal limit, together with all its creeks, inlets and tributaries and all the waters within a 200 metre radius of the mouth of Coffs Creek where it meets the South Pacific Ocean, including that part of Park Beach.
Condition: This schedule applies to all species of fish, including all finfish and shellfish (such as oysters).	

Note: This closure applies to all fishers. The purpose of the closure is to help protect public health and safety from potentially contaminated marine life.
