Act No. 69 2004 – An Act to amend the Aboriginal Land Rights Act 1983 to make provision for the validity of Gandangara Estate land dealings by the Gandangara Local Aboriginal Land Council. [**Aboriginal Land Rights Amendment (Gandangara Estate) Bill**]

Explanatory note

Section 4 of the *Anglican Church of Australia (Bodies Corporate) Act 1938* provides that persons who, for the time being, are members of an unincorporated body that is constituted by an ordinance of the Synod of a diocese for the purpose of managing, governing or controlling an institution or organisation of the Anglican Church of Australia, or of holding, managing or dealing with any church trust property, may be the subject of a declaration by an ordinance of that Synod that it is expedient to constitute them as a body corporate. Once the ordinance making the declaration is passed, the Governor may, by order published in the Gazette, declare the members of the unincorporated body to be a body corporate.

The object of this Order is to declare that the members of the Armidale School Council are a body corporate known as "The Armidale School Council". The relevant ordinances are *The Armidale School Council Incorporation Ordinance 1971*, *The Armidale School Incorporation Ordinance Amending Ordinance 1978–1990* and *The Armidale School Ordinance 1978–2000*.

This Order is made under section 4 (3) of the *Anglican Church of Australia (Bodies Corporate) Act 1938*.

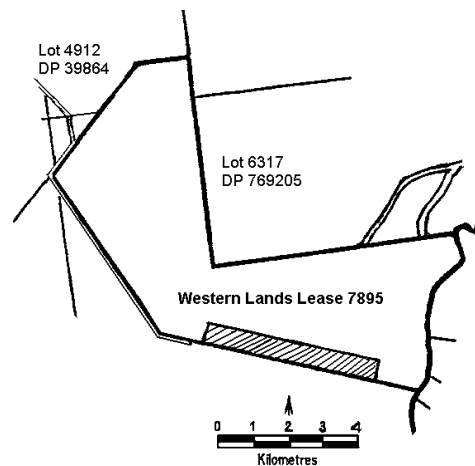

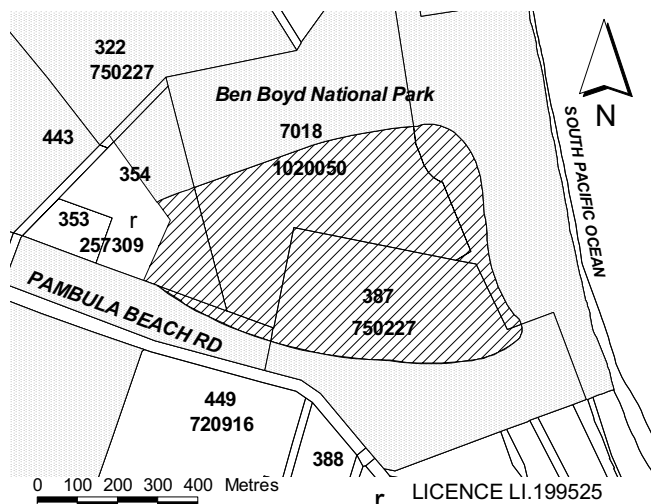

VALUERS REGULATION 2004

Invitation to Comment

THE Valuers Act was passed by the NSW Parliament in May 2003. When the new Act comes into effect at the end of 2004, it will replace the current Act and repeal the current Regulation.

The new Act introduces a number of reforms to the laws governing registered valuers in NSW.

The Office of Fair Trading has developed a draft Regulation which sets out the administrative detail needed to enable the new Act to be effectively administered and to support the consumer protection objectives of the Act.

Matters dealt with in the draft Regulation include:

- That aquaculture leases and commercial fishing licenses under the Fisheries Management Act 1994 are taken to be property for the purposes of the Act;
