FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994

Section 8 Notification – Fishing Closure
Coffs Creek and its tributaries

I, Richard Sheldrake, prohibit the taking of fish by the methods of fishing described in Column 1 of the Schedule to this notification, from waters in Column 2 of that Schedule.

This prohibition is effective for a period of 60 days from the date of publication, unless sooner varied or revoked by notification of Deputy Director-General, Agriculture and Fisheries.

Note: The word 'Regulation', where appearing in this notification, refers to the Fisheries Management (General) Regulation 2002

Coffs Creek and its tributaries – bi valve shellfish

<i>Column 1</i> Methods	<i>Column 2</i> Waters
All methods.	The whole of the waters of Coffs Creek from its upper tidal limit, together with all its creeks, inlets and tributaries, to the mouth of Coffs Creek where it meets the Pacific Ocean.

Coffs Creek and its tributaries – finfish and crustaceans

<i>Column 1</i> Methods	<i>Column 2</i> Waters
All methods.	The waters of Coffs Creek with all its creeks, inlets and tributaries upstream of the Promenade Shopping Centre.
