FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994

Section 8 Renewal and section 11 Notification – Fishing Closure

NSW Inland Waters

I, Richard Sheldrake, prohibit the taking of fish by the methods of fishing specified in Column 1 of Schedules 1 to 46 of this notification, from waters shown opposite in Column 2 and for the time period shown opposite in Column 3, respectively, of those schedules, with the exception of schedules 44,45,46 which permit the methods of fishing specified in Column 1, from waters shown opposite in Column 2 for the time period shown opposite in Column 3, respectively, of those schedules. This prohibition will be effective for a period of five (5) years from the 8 June 2005, unless otherwise specified in the further conditions of this notification.

The previous General Inland Waters notification as published in the NSW Government Gazette no.68, dated 9 June 2000, has been amended under section 11, by the deletion of Schedule 6, Darling and Barwon Rivers & Tributaries Yabby traps. All other schedules in this closure remain the same.

This notification will be effective for a period of five years effective from 8 June 2005.
