SPECIAL SUPPLEMENT

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1993 – PROCLAMATION

Marie Bashir, AC, Governor

I, Professor Marie Bashir AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of Part 1, Chapter 9 and section 736 of the Local Government Act 1993, do, by this Proclamation, declare that the Proclamation published in a Special Supplement of *Government Gazette* No. 90 of 26 May 2004, commencing on page 3184 of that Special Supplement, constituting the new Area of Mid-Western Regional is amended as follows:

Omit Clause 2 (1) of Schedule D from said Proclamation and insert instead:

- (1) The date of the first election of the Councillors of the new Council is 25 March 2006.

HERITAGE ACT 1977

INTERIM HERITAGE ORDER No. 1

89-93 Marine Drive, Tea Gardens
(Lot 1, DP 1021873)

UNDER section 25 of the Heritage Act 1977 Great Lakes Council does by this order:

- (i) make an Interim Heritage Order to cover the item of the environmental heritage specified or described in Schedule `A`; and
- (ii) declare that the Interim Heritage Order shall apply to the curtilage or site of such item, being the land described in Schedule `B`.

This Interim Heritage Order will lapse six (6) months from the date that it is made unless the local Council has passed a resolution before that date either:

1. in the case of an item which, in the council's opinion, is of local significance, to place the item on the heritage schedule of a local environmental plan with appropriate provisions for protecting and managing the item; and
2. in the case of an item which, in the Council's opinion, is of State heritage significance, nominate the item for inclusion on the State Heritage Register.
