### **FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994**

Section 8 and 9 Notification – Fishing Closure

Port Jackson

Taking of prawns by all methods

I, IAN MACDONALD, M.L.C., Minister for Primary Industries, revoke the fishing closure notification published in *Government Gazette* No. 150 of 2 December 2005, which refers to the taking of prawns by all methods.

I do now, by this Notification prohibit, except as permitted below, the taking of prawns by all fishing methods in all waters of Port Jackson and its tributaries, upstream of a line drawn from the northern extremity of South Head to southern extremity of North Head.

A commercial fisher that holds an endorsement in the Port Jackson Estuary Prawn Trawl Fishery may take prawns provided they are taken and sold in accordance with the following conditions:

1. Any prawns taken must not be sold for human consumption.
2. All prawns taken must be landed from the vessel at the Sydney Fish Markets, and supplied directly to Sydney Fish Market Pty Ltd for on-sale as bait to outlets approved by the Deputy Director-General Agriculture and Fisheries and Regional Relations of the Department of Primary Industries (DPI).

This notification takes effect at 5 p.m. on 9 January 2006 and remains in effect until midnight on 3 February 2006 unless sooner varied or revoked.
