Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is extend the period for compliance for persons who undertake construction work to hold an OHS induction training certificate until 1 September 2006.

This Regulation is made under the *Occupational Health and Safety Act 2000*, including section 33 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Occupational Health and Safety Amendment (OHS Induction Training) Regulation 2006*.

2 Amendment of Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001

The *Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001* is amended by omitting from clauses 213 (1B), 214 (1B) and 215A (3) the matter “29 March 2006” wherever occurring and by inserting instead the matter “1 September 2006”.
