### FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994

#### Section 8 Notification – Fishing Closure

#### Tailor

I, Ian Macdonald, prohibit the taking of fish described in Column 1 of the schedule to this notification, by the holder of an endorsed commercial fishing licence, by the methods of fishing specified in Column 2, from waters described in Column 3, for a period of five years commencing midnight 31 August 2006.

To avoid waste this closure is subject to the following condition that during any calendar day, or on any fishing trip from the time of departure to the time of return to any place when longer than 24 hours, commercial fishers using lawful commercial nets may retain a by-catch of tailor from normal fishing operations of no more than 100kg whole weight of each species in possession by any hauling crew, or 50kg in possession by any meshing crew (or individual), or 50kg on board any other licensed commercial fishing vessel containing any commercial fishing net.
