Interim Heritage Order No. 108

Old Adaminaby remains, Lake Eucumbene

IN pursuance of Section 24 of the Heritage Act, 1977, I, the Minister for Planning, do, by this my order:

- (i) make an interim heritage order in respect of the item of the environmental heritage specified or described in Schedule 'A';
- (ii) declare that the interim heritage order shall apply to the curtilage or site of such item, being the land described in Schedule 'B'; and
- (iii) declare the order is subject to the exemptions from approval under Section 57(2) of the Heritage Act, 1977, described in Schedule "C" and in addition to the standard exemptions.

Schedule "A"

The property known as Old Adaminaby, situated in Lake Eucumbene on the land described in Schedule "B".

Schedule "B"

All those pieces or parcels of land in Parish of Adaminiby, Addicumbene, Bolaira, Buckenderra, Bullenbalong, Cabramurra, Clyde, Crackenback, Eucumbene, Jinderboine, Kalkite, Middlingbank, Nimmo, Nungar, Seymour, Townsend, Wallgome, County of Wallace, shown on the plan catalogued HC2221 in the office of the Heritage Council of New South Wales.

Schedule "C"

1. Activities that will not demolish, alter, excavate or move town remains from Old Adaminaby, above or below the water line, for any of the following purposes:
 - a. Fishing
 - b. Recreation
 - c. Dam maintenance and functions by Snowy Hydro Limited
 - d. Water storage
 - e. Fuel reduction
 - f. Agriculture
