
Declaration of Restricted Area – Coonabarabran

I, STEPHEN ELLIOTT DUNN, Deputy Chief Veterinary Officer, with the powers the Minister has delegated to me under section 67 of the Exotic Diseases of Animals Act 1991 and pursuant to section 15 of that Act and being of the opinion that the area specified in Schedule 1 may be or become infected with the exotic disease Equine influenza hereby declare:

1. the area specified in Schedule 1 to be a restricted area, and
2. that the classes of animals, animal products, fodder, fittings or vehicles to which this order applies are those described in Schedule 2.


Declaration of Restricted Area – Suburb of Kirkham within the Local Government Areas of Camden


