## ORDER - Section 15


## Declaration of Restricted Area – Parkes

I, STEPHEN ELLIOTT DUNN, Deputy Chief Veterinary Officer, with the powers the Minister has delegated to me under section 67 of the Exotic Diseases of Animals Act 1991 (“the Act”) and pursuant to section 15 of the Act:

1. revoke the order declared under section 15 of the Act entitled ‘Declaration of Restricted Area – Parkes’ dated 27 August 2007;
2. declare the area specified in Schedule 1 to be a restricted area; and
3. declare that the classes of animals, animal products, fodder, fittings or vehicles to which this order applies are those described in Schedule 2.

## SCHEDULE 1

The area within a fifteen kilometre (15km) radius of the Parkes Showground, Victoria Street Parkes, 2870 in the State of New South Wales as shown in the map below:

**SCHEDULE 2****Class of animals**

All horses.

**Class of animal products**

All animal products from horses.

**Class of fodder and fittings**

All fodder and fittings from, or used in connection with, horses.

**Class of vehicles**

All vehicles that, since 1 August 2007, have been used in connection with any of the classes of animals, animal products, fodder or fittings described in this Schedule.

In Schedule 2:

“*horses*” means horses, mules, donkeys and other animals in the Equidae family.
