FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994

Section 8 Notification – Fishing Closure

Kalang River

I, DOUGLAS FRAZER HOCKING, Executive Director, Fisheries, Compliance and Regional Relations, pursuant to section 8 of the *Fisheries Management Act 1994*, and with the delegated authority of the Minister for Primary Industries and the Director-General of the NSW Department of Primary Industries pursuant to sections 227 and 228 of the Act, do by this notification, prohibit recreational fishers from taking all species of fish specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this notification, by the methods described opposite in Column 2 of the Schedule from the waters described opposite in Column 3 of the Schedule.

This prohibition is effective for a period of one year from the date of publication of this notification, unless sooner amended or revoked

Schedule

Kalang River

Species	Methods	Waters
All species of mollusca (excluding cephalopods) and all species of barnacles	All fishing methods	From the downstream point of Urunga Island directly across to the southern bank of the Kalang River, upstream to its source, including the waters of Yellow Rock Creek.

In the Schedule to this notification, “cephalopods” includes, but is not limited to, squid, octopus and cuttlefish.

Note: Following consultation with the NSW Food Authority this closure was implemented to protect human health.

Note: This fishing closure operates in addition to the provisions of the fishing closure titled “Bellinger and Kalang Rivers” published in the NSW Government Gazette No. 146 of 12 October 2007 at page 7780.
