REPEAL OF TEMPORARY WATER RESTRICTIONS

Wakool River and Merran Creek Systems
New South Wales Murray Regulated River Water Source

PURSUANT to section 324 (1) of the Water Management Act 2000 (Act), I, David Harriss having delegated authority from the Minister for Water, do, by this Order, repeal the order made under section 324 (1) of the Act dated 25 June 2009 and published in the New South Wales Government Gazette number 95 at page 3795-3696 on 26 June 2009.

This Order takes effect on the date that notice of the order is first published.

- Note:** (1) The effect of this Order is to remove the temporary water restrictions imposed by the order made under section 324 (1) of the Act dated 25 June 2009 and published in the New South Wales Government Gazette number 95 at page, 3795-3696 on 26 June 2009 which imposed temporary water restrictions for the Wakool River and Merran Creek systems, including Waddy Creek and various water sources in the NSW Murray Regulated River Water Source (as identified in the Water Sharing Plan for the NSW Murray and Lower Darling Regulated Rivers Water Sources 2003), in relation to the taking of water pursuant to domestic and stock rights under section 52 of the Act and under domestic and stock access licences, regulated river (high security) access licences and regulated river (general security) access licences.
- (2) Published means that the order is published in the NSW Government Gazette and notice of the order is published in a newspaper(s) circulating throughout the area affected by the order, in accordance with sections 324 (3) and 395 of the Water Management Act 2000.
