### FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994

Section 8 Notification – Fishing Closure

Penrith Weir

I, GEORGE DAVEY, Executive Director, Fisheries, Compliance and Regional Relations, with the delegated authority of the Minister for Primary Industries and the Director-General of the Department of Industry and Investment pursuant to section 227 and 228 of the Fisheries Management Act 1994 (“the Act”), do by this notification pursuant to section 8 of the Act, prohibit the taking of all species of fish, by the methods of fishing specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this notification, from the waters described opposite in Column 2 of that Schedule.

This fishing closure is effective from the date of publication of this notification until 28 February 2010, unless sooner amended or revoked.
