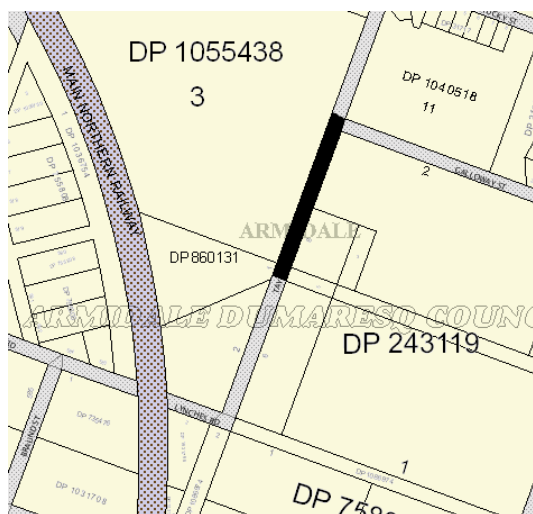

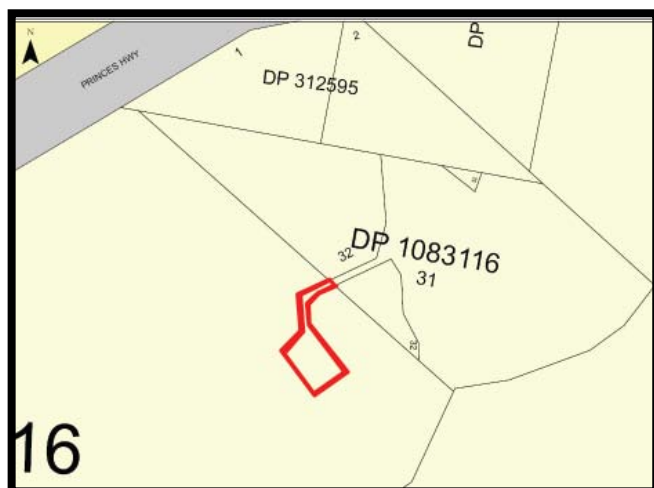

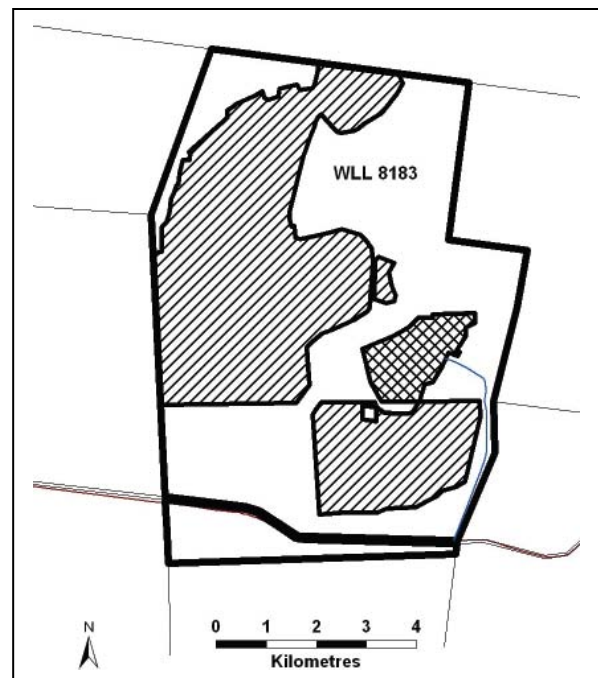
- (1) In the conditions annexed to the lease, the expression “the Minister” means the Minister administering the Western Lands Act 1901, and any power, authority, duty or function conferred or imposed upon the Minister by or under those conditions may be exercised or performed either by the Minister or by such officers of the Department of Lands as the Minister may from time to time approve.
- (2) In these conditions and reservations the expression “the Commissioner” means the Commissioner charged with the administration of the Western Lands Act 1901 (“the Act”) in accordance with section 4(2) of the Act.

- (3) (a) For the purposes of this clause the term Lessor shall include Her Majesty the Queen Her Heirs and Successors the Minister and the agents servants employees and contractors of the Lessor Her Majesty Her Majesty's Heirs and Successors and the Minister.
- (b) The lessee covenants with the Lessor to indemnify and keep indemnified the Lessor from and against all claims for injury loss or damage suffered by any person or body using or being in or upon the Premises or any adjoining land or premises of the Lessor arising out of the Holder's use of the Premises and against all liabilities for costs charges and expenses incurred by the Lessor in respect of the claim of any such person or body except to the extent that any such claims and demands arise wholly from any negligence or wilful act or omission on the part of the Lessor.
- (c) The indemnity contained in this clause applies notwithstanding that this Lease authorised or required the lessee to undertake or perform the activity giving rise to any claim for injury loss or damage.
- (d) The lessee expressly agrees that the obligations of the Holder under this clause shall continue after the expiration or sooner determination of this Lease in respect of any act deed matter or thing occurring before such expiration or determination.
- (4) The rent of the lease shall be assessed in accordance with Part 6 of the Western Lands Act 1901.
- (5) The rent shall be due and payable annually in advance on 1 July in each year.
- (6) (a) "GST" means any tax on goods and/or services, including any value added tax, broad based consumption tax or other similar tax introduced in Australia.
"GST law" includes any Act, order, ruling or regulation, which imposes or otherwise deals with the administration or imposition of a GST in Australia.
- (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement:
- (i) If a GST applies to any supply made by either party under or in connection with this Agreement, the consideration provided or to be provided for that supply will be increased by an amount equal to the GST liability properly incurred by the party making the supply.
- (ii) If the imposition of a GST or any subsequent change in the GST law is accompanied by or undertaken in connection with the abolition of or reduction in any existing taxes, duties or statutory charges (in this clause "taxes"), the consideration payable by the recipient of the supply made under this Agreement will be reduced by the actual costs of the party making the supply that are reduced directly or indirectly as a consequence of the abolition of or reduction in taxes.
- (7) The lessee shall pay all rates and taxes assessed on or in respect of the land leased during the currency of the lease.
- (8) The lessee shall hold and use the land leased bona fide for the lessee's own exclusive benefit and shall not transfer, convey or assign the land or any portion thereof without having first obtained the written consent of the Minister.
- (9) The lessee shall not enter into a sublease of the land leased unless the sublease specifies the purpose for which the land may be used under the sublease, and it is a purpose which is consistent with the purpose for which the land may be used under this lease.
- (10) If the lessee enters into a sublease of the land leased, the lessee must notify the Commissioner of the granting of the sublease within 28 days after it is granted.
- (11) The land leased shall be used only for the purpose of **Grazing, Cultivation and Feedlot**.
- (12) The lessee shall maintain and keep in reasonable repair all improvements on the land leased during the currency of the lease and shall permit the Minister or the Commissioner or any person authorised by the Minister or the Commissioner at all times to enter upon and examine the whole or any part of the land leased and the buildings or other improvements thereon.
- (13) All minerals within the meaning of the Mining Act 1992, and all other metals, gemstones and semiprecious stones, which may be in, under or upon the land leased are reserved to the Crown and the lessee shall permit any person duly authorised in that behalf to enter upon the land leased and search, work, win and remove all or any minerals, metals, gemstones and semiprecious stones in, under or upon the land leased.
- (14) Mining operations may be carried on, upon and in the lands below the land leased and upon and in the lands adjoining the land leased and the lands below those lands and metals and minerals may be removed therefrom and the Crown and any lessee or lessees under any Mining Act or Acts shall not be subject to any proceedings by way of injunction or otherwise in respect of or be liable for any damage occasioned by the letting down, subsidence or lateral movement of the land leased or any part thereof or otherwise by reason of the following acts and matters, that is to say, by reason of the Crown or any person on behalf of the Crown or any lessee or lessees, having worked now or hereafter working any mines or having carried on or now or hereafter carrying on mining operations or having searched for, worked, won or removed or now or hereafter searching for, working, winning or removing any metals or minerals under, in or from the lands lying beneath the land leased or any part thereof, or on, in, under or from any other lands situated laterally to the land leased or any part thereof or the lands lying beneath those lands, and whether on or below the surface of those other lands and by reason of those acts and matters or in the course thereof the Crown reserves the liberty and authority for the Crown, any person on behalf of the Crown and any lessee or lessees from time to time to let down without payment of any compensation any part of the land leased or of the surface thereof.
- (15) The lessee shall comply with the provisions of the Local Government Act 1993, and of the ordinances made thereunder.

- (16) The lessee shall comply with the provisions of the Water Management Act 2000 and any regulations made in pursuance of that Act.
- (17) The lessee shall not erect or permit any person to erect any buildings or extend any existing buildings on the land leased except to the satisfaction of the Commissioner.
- (18) The lessee shall ensure that the land leased is kept in a neat and tidy condition to the satisfaction of the Commissioner and not permit refuse to accumulate on the land.
- (19) Upon termination or forfeiture of the lease the Commissioner may direct that the former lessee shall remove any structure or material from the land at his own cost and without compensation. - (37) The lessee shall not remove or permit any person to remove gravel, stone, clay, shells or other material for the purpose of sale from the land leased unless the lessee or the person is the holder of a quarry license under regulations made under the Crown Lands Act 1989 or, in respect of land in a State forest, unless the lessee or the person is the holder of a forest materials licence under the Forestry Act 1916, and has obtained the special authority of the Minister to operate on the land, but the lessee may, with the approval of the Commissioner, take from the land such gravel, stone, clay, shells or other material for building and other purposes upon the land as may be required by the lessee.
- (38) The lessee shall comply with the provisions of the Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997 particularly in relation to disposal of tailwaters or waters which may be contaminated with fertiliser, herbicide or pesticide or similar chemicals.
- (39) The lessee shall not clear any native vegetation within the area shown cross hatched on the diagram hereunder unless written approval has been granted by the local Catchment Management Authority.
- (40) The lessee shall only Dryland Cultivate within the boundaries of the area gazetted. An area of 2689 ha (shown hatched on the diagram below) is authorised for cultivation. Cultivation outside this area will only be allowable with the written consent of the Commissioner or Minister.
- (41) The lessee shall ensure that cultivation and associated activities do not interfere with any road formation within the allowable area.
- (42) The lessee shall not cultivate within the channel of incised drainage lines (other than man made structures) which carry water after storms in the channels, nor cultivate within a distance of 20 metres on either side of the banks of the channels, except when otherwise specified by the Western Lands Commissioner.
- (43) The lessee shall cease work immediately should any Aboriginal archaeological relics or sites be uncovered during the proposed works (Aboriginal Sites are protected under the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974, and are extremely vulnerable to many kinds of agricultural development.).
- (44) The lessee shall consider the requirements of the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974 with regard to Aboriginal relics. Under Section 90 it is an offence to damage or destroy relics without prior consent of the Director General of the National Parks and Wildlife Service (NPWS). If a site is discovered the lessee shall contact the Manager, Cultural Heritage Unit, National Parks and Wildlife Services on Phone (02) 6883 5324 or at 58 62 Wingewarra St, Dubbo.
- (45) The lessee shall establish windbreaks at his/her own expense, as may be ordered by the Western Lands Commissioner to provide adequate protection of the soil.
- (46) The lessee shall ensure that stubble and other crop residue is retained on the soil surface and shall not be burnt, except with the written approval of the Western Lands Commissioner or his delegate. Where such approval is granted, stubble burning shall be carried out with the approval as per requirements of the NSW Rural Fire Services.
- (47) The lessee shall undertake any appropriate measures, at his/her own expense, ordered by the Commissioner to rehabilitate any degraded cultivated areas.
- (48) The lessee shall not permanently transfer Irrigation water from the lease without the prior written permission of the Western Lands Commissioner.
- (49) Access tracks to the area to be cultivated must be arranged in such a manner as to minimise the disturbance of any land surfaces within the areas required to be left uncultivated to comply with the conditions of this Change of Lease Purpose.
- (50) The lessee must ensure that sandhills and other soils with a surface texture of loamy sand or coarser are left uncultivated unless specifically approved by the commissioner.
- (51) Texture contrast (or duplex) soils are soil types which have a sandy to loamy topsoil abruptly overlaying a clay subsoil and are prone to scolding (producing claypans and hummocks). Land within 60 metres of any texture contrast or duplex soil area shall not be cultivated except in accordance with a plan approved by the Commissioner.
- (52) Areas with a slope greater than 2% shall not be cultivated until any soil conservation measures documented in a plan approved by the Commissioner have been implemented at the lessee's expense.
- (53) Cultivation and cropping are not to alter the natural flood regime. Crops are not to be protected by levees.
- (54) The lessee shall ensure that there be no cultivation within the 400 metre wide buffer between the southern-most two areas gazetted for cultivation. This area is to remain permanently uncultivated.
- (55) The lessee shall only conduct a feedlot within the boundaries of the area of 234 hectares shown cross hatched on the diagram below. Any other feedlot operation outside this area will only be allowable with the consent of the Commissioner or the Minister.
- (56) The lessee shall ensure development is in strict accordance with all the 17 Conditions of Development Consent No 6 1996 (approved and issued on 28/09/2004 by Brewarrina Shire Council).
- (57) The lessee shall ensure that development is in strict accordance with the proposal set out in the Environment Impact Statement (EIS) lodged with the application made to and approved by Brewarrina Shire Council.
- (58) The lessee shall comply with all conditions of any and all Environment Protection Licence (s) issued under the Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997 by the Department of Environment and Climate Change.
- (59) The lessee shall ensure that any necessary approvals (licences and consents) from other Government Agencies and/or Statutory Authorities are granted prior to the commencement of any activity associated with the proposal.

- (60) The lessee shall not clear any native vegetation or remove any timber within the area of the feedlot unless written approval has been granted by the appropriate authority.
- (61) The lessee shall undertake all necessary works to prevent soil erosion arising from or contributed to by the construction and operation of the feedlot.
- (62) The lessee shall implement dust suppression measures as deemed necessary to control dust generated as a direct result of the construction and operation of the feedlot.

in Respect of Wild Dogs

Pest Control Order Number 17

I, IAN MACDONALD, M.L.C., Minister for Primary Industries, revoke Pest Control Order Number 11 in respect of wild dogs dated 3 October 2006 and published in *NSW Government Gazette* No. 122 of 6 October 2006 at pages 8689 to 8690 and any order revived as a result of this revocation and I make this order pursuant to Part 11 of, and clause 27 (2) of Schedule 7 to, the Rural Lands Protection Act 1998 ("the Act").

1. This order applies, pursuant to section 143 (1) (a) of the Act to the land described in Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 below ("the controlled land").
2. In this order "wild dog" means any dog, including a dingo, that is or has become wild but excludes any dog kept in accordance with the Companion Animals Act 1998, the Exhibited Animals Protection Act 1986 and the Animal Research Act 1985 or any other legislation made in replacement of any of those Acts.

3. I declare, pursuant to section 143 (1) (b) of the Act the wild dog, a former pest within the meaning of clause 27 (1) of Schedule 7 to the Act to be a pest on the controlled land ("the pest").
4. I impose, pursuant to sections 143 (1) (c) and 143 (2) (a) of the Act a general destruction obligation requiring the occupier of controlled land to eradicate the pest by any lawful method.
5. I empower, pursuant to sections 143 (1) (c) and 143 (2) (d) of the Act all authorities to serve an individual eradication order in accordance with Part 11 of the Act on any occupier or owner (other than a public authority) of controlled land in their district requiring the occupier or owner to eradicate the pest by use of a method specified by the authority in the order.
6. I confer, pursuant to sections 143 (1) (c) and 143 (2) (h) of the Act on all authorities a power to approve or order the use (whether or not subject to any condition) of a method of eradication of the pest.
 Note: Section 156 (4) of the Act provides that an occupier of controlled public land (in this order described in Schedule 2) fulfils their general destruction obligation provided the occupier uses the method or methods approved by the authority for the district. In practice, this approval under section 143 (2) (h) of the Act will take the form of a wild dog management plan, the content of which will be agreed between the occupier and the authority. Such management plan will address, in accordance with a Guideline issued by the State Council under section 25 of the Act both control and conservation objectives.
7. I specify, pursuant to section 143 (3) of the Act the following method of eradication as a method that may be used in relation to the pest on controlled land that involves the application of a substance or thing from the air, namely, using any substance approved for application by air under the Pesticides Act 1999 or the AgVet Code for the purpose of controlling the pest.
8. This order has effect for a period of 5 years.

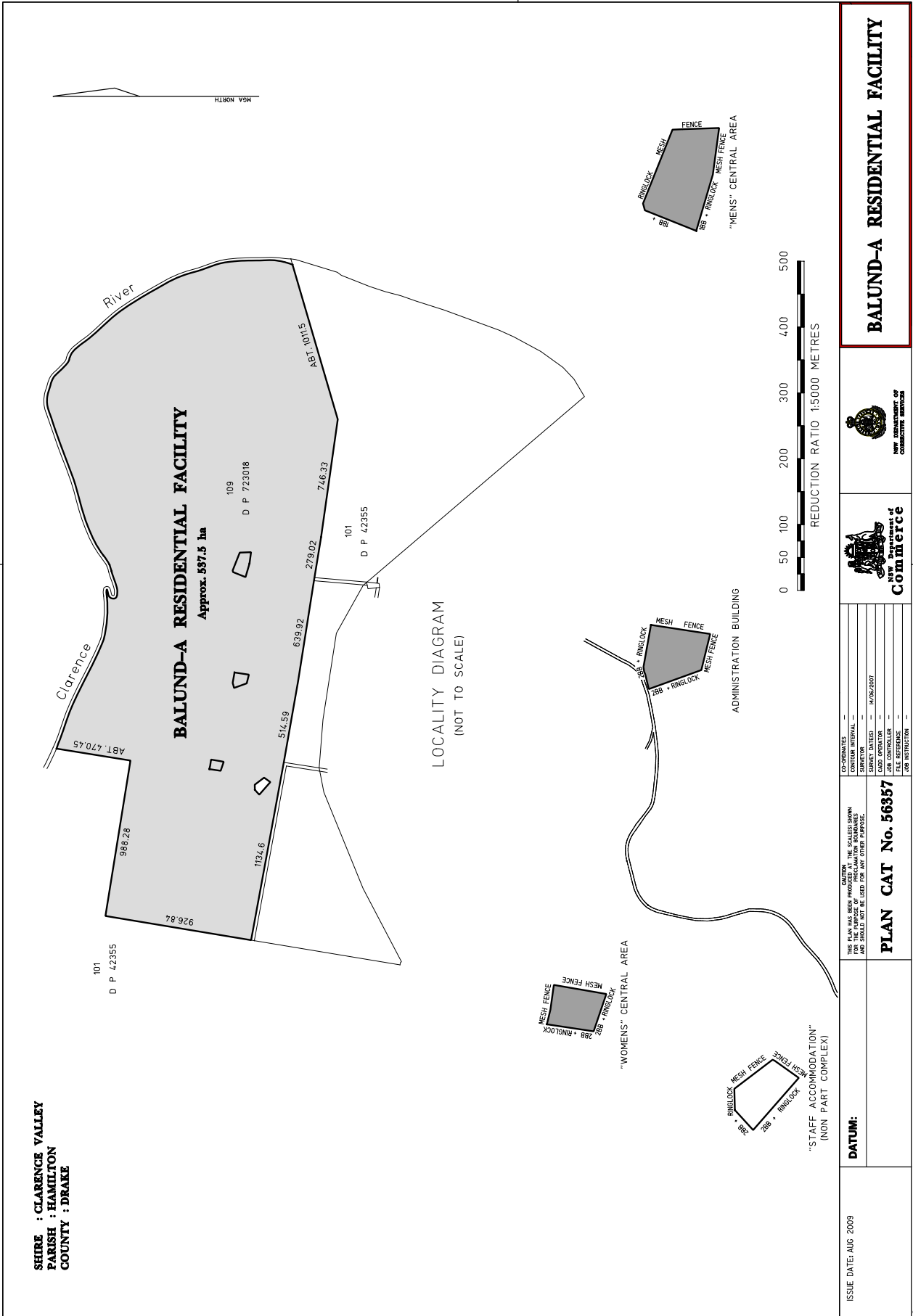
