SUBORDINATE LEGISLATION ACT 1989

Public Consultation on Proposed Coastal Protection Regulation 2011

NOTICE is given in accordance with section 5 of Subordinate Legislation Act 1989 of the intention to make a regulation under the Coastal Protection Act 1979.

The Coastal Protection Act 1979 was recently amended by the Coastal Protection and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2010. These amendments improved the arrangements for managing coastal erosion risks. The principal objective of the proposed Regulation is to support the recent amendments to the Coastal Protection Act 1979. The main provisions of the proposed Regulation are:

- Requirements relating to emergency coastal protection works by landowners
- Requirements relating to Ministerial concurrences for certain off-shore development activities
- The categorisation of coastal hazards to land
- Penalty notices

A Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) has been prepared in accordance with the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989. The RIS considers the costs and benefits of the proposals.
