Call for Submissions on the proposed Water Management (General) Regulation 2011

THE Water Management Act 2000, establishes a framework for sustainable water management in NSW. Section 400 of the Act enables the making of regulations to support implementation. Two current regulations are the Water Management (General) Regulation 2004 and the Water Management (Water Supply Authorities) Regulation 2004. These regulations will be repealed on 1 September 2011, in accordance with the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989.

NSW Office of Water proposes to reinstate and amalgamate the regulations with amended provisions. A draft Water Management (General) Regulation 2011 is now available for public comment. The draft Regulation and Regulatory Impact Statement can be downloaded from the NSW Office of Water website at www.water.nsw.gov.au under Water management > Law and policy > Legal reform.
