ANIMAL DISEASES (EMERGENCY OUTBREAKS) ACT 1991

ORDER – Section 76

Certification that an outbreak of the emergency animal disease Hendra virus exists in part of New South Wales

I, MARK I PATERSON, AO, Director General of the Department of Trade and Investment, Regional Infrastructure and Services, with the powers the Minister has delegated to me pursuant to section 67 of the Animal Diseases (Emergency Outbreaks) Act 1991 (“the Act”) and pursuant to section 76 of the Act, certify that an outbreak of the emergency animal disease Hendra virus exists:

1. in a premises in the vicinity of Wollongbar which was quarantined pursuant to section 35 of the Act on 30 June 2011;
and
2. in a premises in the vicinity of Macksville which was quarantined pursuant to section 35 of the Act on 7 July 2011,
in New South Wales.
