Direction pursuant to Section 34(1)(a) to List an Item on the State Heritage Register

Sydney Cove West Archaeological Precinct
SHR No. 1860

IN pursuance of section 34(1)(a) of the Heritage Act 1977, I, the Minister for Planning, having considered a recommendation of the Heritage Council of New South Wales, direct the Council to list the item of environmental heritage specified in Schedule "A" on the State Heritage Register. This listing shall apply to the curtilage or site of the item, defined as the archaeological layer only of the land described in Schedule "B" and excluding the foundations of current buildings. The listing is subject to the exemptions from approval under section 57(2) of the Heritage Act 1977, described in Schedule "C" and in addition to the standard exemptions.

Minor excavation works which occur above any known fill layers. Only applicable where fill layers are confirmed to exist through prior archaeological work.

6. Part Lot 1, DP 876516 at Sydney Overseas Passenger Terminal

All above ground works and activities that do not involve any excavation and which will be undertaken on the parcel of land known as Part Lot 1, DP 876516, in the Parish of St Philip, County of Cumberland, shown on the plan catalogued HC 2384 in the office of the Heritage Council of New South Wales.

7. Sydney Water Corporation assets within First Fleet Park

Works by Sydney Water Corporation on Sydney Water Corporation assets, including sewerage systems, stormwater management systems and water supply systems, within First Fleet Park for operational requirements, maintenance and repair that do not involve any excavation or impacts on the archaeological resource.
