MENTAL HEALTH ACT 2007

Section 109

Declaration of Mental Health Facility

I, Dr Mary Foley, Director-General of the NSW Department of Health, pursuant to section 109 of the Mental Health Act 2007, DO HEREBY

- (a) DECLARE the Community Rehabilitation Service, situated at 40 Jamieson Street, Granville NSW 2142, to be a declared mental health facility under the Mental Health Act 2007; and
- (b) DECLARE this facility to be designated in the class of facilities known as “community health care agencies” for the purposes of section 109 (2) (a); and
- (c) RESTRICT this facility to the provision of services and performance of functions necessary for or associated with the administration or management of community treatment orders under the following provisions of the Mental Health Act 2007:
 - i. Part 3 of Chapter 3 (except for sections 61, 61A, 62 and 63);
 - ii. Chapter 4; and
 - iii. Chapter 5 (except for sections 111 and 112 and Division 2 of Part 2)

FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 1994

Section 197E – Aquatic Reserve Notification

I, KATRINA HODGKINSON, M.P., Minister for Primary Industries, do by this aquatic reserve notification:

1. pursuant to section 197H of the Fisheries Management Act 1994 (“the Act”), revoke the aquatic reserve notification published in *NSW Government Gazette* No. 116 on 15 September 2006 at page 8055 and any aquatic reserve notification revived as a result of this revocation; and
2. pursuant to section 197E of the Act prohibit the carrying out of the activities specified in Column 2 of the Schedule to this notification, in the whole of the aquatic reserves specified in Column 1 of the Schedule.

This notification is effective for a period of three (3) years commencing on the date of publication in the *NSW Government Gazette*, unless sooner amended or revoked.

Barrenjoey Head Boat Harbour Bronte-Coogee Cape Banks Narrabeen Head	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The taking of the tunicate ‘cunjevoi’ – <i>Pyura spp.</i>, and all invertebrates (including anemones, barnacles, chitons, cockles, crabs, mussels, octopus, oysters, pipis, sea urchins, sea stars, snails, worms) with the exception of eastern rock lobster (<i>Jasus verreauxi</i>), southern rock lobster (<i>Jasus novaehollandiae</i>) and abalone (<i>Haliotis rubra</i>). • Collecting, destroying or interfering with any marine vegetation, with the exception of sea lettuce (<i>Ulva lactuca</i>) and bait weed (<i>Enteromorpha intestinalis</i>).
Cabbage Tree Bay	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Taking or attempting to take, gathering, destroying, injuring or interfering with any fish (including invertebrates) or marine vegetation (whether dead or alive).

1. The below Table, in Column 2, sets out a non-exhaustive list of examples of activities that are permitted in the aquatic reserves specified in Column 1 of the Table.

2. The boundaries of the aquatic reserves specified in this notification are described (including maps) in the Declaration of Aquatic Reserves published in *NSW Government Gazette* No. 65 on 22 March 2002 at pages 1731 to 1732.
3. This notification does not affect any fishing closure under section 8 of the Act that also applies to the aquatic reserves specified in this notification.

ANIMAL DISEASES (EMERGENCY OUTBREAKS) ACT 1991

IMPORTATION ORDER – Section 28

I, THERESE MARGARET WRIGHT, Deputy Chief Veterinary Officer, with the powers the Minister has delegated to me pursuant to section 67 of the Animal Diseases (Emergency Outbreaks) Act 1991 ('the Act') and pursuant to section 28 of the Act on the basis that I reasonably suspect an area outside the State to be infected with the emergency animal disease Avian Paramyxovirus, prohibit the entry or importation into the State of:

- (a) pigeons.
- (b) pigeon eggs.
- (c) fittings used in connection with pigeons, including cages and equipment, unless such fittings have been cleaned and disinfected to remove traces of any animal product from pigeons and any fodder used in connection with pigeons.

This Importation Order remains in force for a period of 30 days commencing on the date it is signed, unless revoked or extended by notice published in the Gazette.
