Order Declaring Development to be a Project under Part 3A of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979
Amendment

I, the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure, pursuant to section 75B(5) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment 1979 (Act), amend the project declaration made under section 75B of the Act on 7 April 2006 (*New South Wales Government Gazette* No. 52 of 13 April 2006, Folio 2223), by amending the development described in the Schedule to that order, by replacing it with the development described in the Schedule 1 to this order.

In my opinion, the development referred to in the Schedule 1 of this order is of State and regional environmental planning significance.

SCHEDULE 1

Development for the purposes of the North West Rail Link, being the construction and operation of a new electrified passenger rail line between Epping and Rouse Hill, including:

- new stations in the localities of Cherrybrook, Castle Hill, Hills Centre, Norwest, Kellyville and Rouse Hill; and
- associated ancillary infrastructure, including but not limited to train stabling, roadways, car parks, bus interchanges, public amenities and intermodal facilities.

Development does not include:

- investigation (including geotechnical and other testing, surveying and sampling) at, above or below the surface of the ground;
- site establishment, including demolition and minor road modifications;
- minor relocation and provision of utility services;
- maintenance or repair of an existing rail infrastructure facility;
- upgrading or maintenance of landscaping and vegetation management or clearing; and
- maintenance of the development.
