## SPECIAL SUPPLEMENT

### STATE EMERGENCY AND RESCUE MANAGEMENT ACT 1989 – ORDER

I, The Hon. Barry O'Farrell, Premier, pursuant to section 60D of the State Emergency and Rescue Management Act 1989, do by this my Order, declare that the provisions of Part 3A of that Act apply to all volunteer emergency workers from the NSW State Emergency Service, Rural Fire Service, Fire and Rescue NSW, Ambulance Service of NSW or any NSW volunteer rescue units, carrying out or supporting flood operations in the following Local Government Areas:
