ORDER – Section 21

Declaration of Control Area

I, SALLY ANN SPENCE, Deputy Chief Veterinary Officer, with the powers the Minister has delegated to me pursuant to section 67 of the Animal Diseases (Emergency Outbreaks) Act 1991 ('the Act') and pursuant to section 21 of the Act and being of the opinion that it is reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing the spread of the emergency animal disease Avian Paramyxovirus, do hereby declare the state of New South Wales to be a control area.

ANIMAL DISEASES (EMERGENCY OUTBREAKS) ACT 1991

Section 22 Control Order

I, SALLY ANN SPENCE, Deputy Chief Veterinary Officer, with the powers the Minister has delegated to me pursuant to section 67 of the Animal Diseases (Emergency Outbreaks) Act 1991 ('the Act') and pursuant to section 22 of the Act hereby:

1. prohibit the holding of markets, fairs, sales, shows, parades, race meetings or other gatherings or competitions involving pigeons within the Control Area;
2. prohibit the presence or exposure of pigeons at any place where pigeons are exposed for exhibition, parade, race meetings or any form of recreation or competition; and
3. prohibit the movement of pigeons into the Control Area from Victoria unless the movement is made in accordance with the importation order titled "Importation order – Pigeons (No. 3)" dated 1 June 2012 and published in the *NSW Government Gazette* No. 58 on 4 June 2012 at pages 2319-2320.

Definitions:

In this Control Order:

Control Area means the state of New South Wales being the control area declared, pursuant to section 21 of the Act by the Order made by the Deputy Chief Veterinary Officer on 28 June 2012.

Pigeon means any bird of the family Columbidae.

Instrument of Determination of Management Charge for Lobster Fishery

I, ANDREW GOULSTONE, Director, Commercial Fisheries with the delegated authority of the Minister for Primary Industries and the Director-General pursuant to sections 227 and 228 of the Fisheries Management Act 1994 (“the Act”) and pursuant to sections 76 (1) and (2) of the Act do hereby determine the management charge for the period 1 July 2012 to 30 June 2013 payable by holders of shares in the lobster fishery (as described in Schedule 1 to the Act) to be \$49.32 per share.
