Section 20

Revocation of declarations of public lands for hunting

I, KATRINA ANN HODGKINSON, M.P., Minister for Primary Industries, pursuant to section 20(11) of the Game and Feral Animal Control Act 2002 ("the Act"), revoke all declarations of public lands for hunting made pursuant to section 20(2) of the Act that are in force, including but not limited to:

1. those declarations made on the date specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 and published in the *New South Wales Government Gazette* as specified in Column 2 of Schedule 1 in relation to the State Forests specified in Column 3 of Schedule 1; and
2. those declarations made on the date specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 and published in the *New South Wales Government Gazette* as specified in Column 2 of Schedule 2 in relation to the Crown Land specified in Column 3 of Schedule 2.
