It is hereby notified, for general information, that His Excellency the Governor, has, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, this day assented to the under mentioned Acts passed by the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, viz.:

Act No. 82 — An Act to amend the *Crime Commission Act 2012* with respect to the Crime Commission's powers to obtain evidence by way of compulsory examinations and the disclosure of evidence so obtained by the Commission, investigations by the Crime Commission in co-operation with external persons and authorities and other miscellaneous matters; and to amend the *Crimes (Appeal and Review) Act 2001* to limit certain appeals relating to Crime Commission examinations and evidence. [**Crime Commission Legislation Amendment Bill**]

Act No. 83 — An Act to amend the *Criminal Procedure Act 1986* with respect to evidence in proceedings for domestic violence offences. [**Criminal Procedure Amendment (Domestic Violence Complainants) Bill**]

Act No. 84 — An Act to make miscellaneous amendments to various Acts that relate to health practitioners. [**Health Practitioner Regulation Legislation Amendment Bill**]

Act No. 85 — An Act to amend the *Mental Health Act 2007* with respect to the admission, discharge, care, treatment and review of patients and other persons; and for other purposes. [**Mental Health Amendment (Statutory Review) Bill**]

Act No. 86 — An Act to amend the *Ombudsman Act 1974* with respect to the giving of evidence; and to amend the *Public Interest Disclosures Act 1994* with respect to reporting requirements and the referral of matters. [**Ombudsman and Public Interest Disclosures Legislation Amendment Bill**]

Act No. 87 — An Act to amend the *Petroleum (Onshore) Act 1991* to provide for certain pending applications for petroleum titles to be expunged. [**Petroleum (Onshore) Amendment (NSW Gas Plan) Bill**]

Act No. 88 — An Act to repeal certain Acts and instruments and to amend certain other Acts and instruments in various respects and for the purpose of effecting statute law revision; and to make certain savings. [**Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Bill (No 2)**]

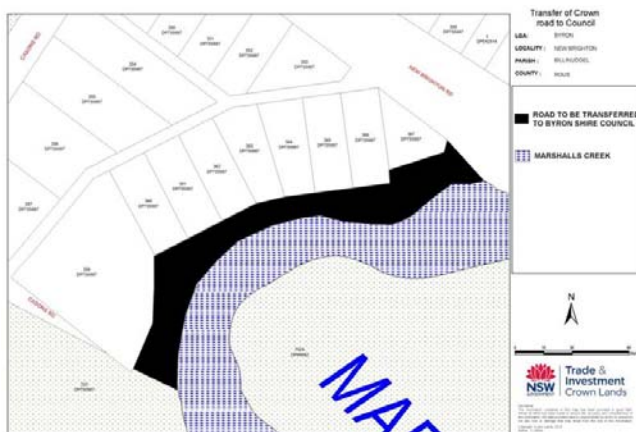

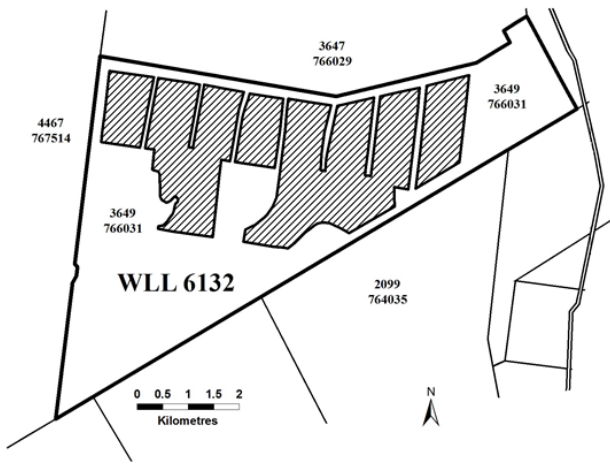

- (2) Texture contrast (or duplex) soils are soil types which have a sandy to loamy topsoil abruptly overlaying a clay subsoil and are prone to scolding (producing claypans and hummocks). Land within 60 metres of any texture contrast or duplex soil area shall not be cultivated except in accordance with a plan approved by the Commissioner.
- (3) Areas with a slope greater than 2% shall not be cultivated until any soil conservation measures documented in a plan approved by the Commissioner have been implemented at the lessee's expense.

 - (i) citizenship, as declared;
 - (ii) country of birth; or
 - (iii) substantive contacts, where such contacts objectively create an unacceptable risk of diversion of ITAR Controlled Material or technology;

but not on the basis of the prospective employee's descent, or ethnic or ethno-religious or national origin;
- h. advertise controlled positions with the Applicants as being subject to the Exemption Order;

- i. record and maintain a register ("Register") of those employees and contractors that are permitted to access ITAR Controlled Material or work on controlled projects due to citizenship, or country of birth status. Access to the register to be limited to only those employees, (including contractors' staff), contract workers and agents of the Applicants with a need to know; and
 - j. ask present and future employees and contractors to execute a non-disclosure agreement in accordance with the licence or Technical Assistance Agreement required by the Department of State, United States of America, in the event they are authorised to have access to ITAR Controlled Material.
 - k. ask present and future employees and contractors to disclose their substantive contacts with individuals from restricted or prohibited countries listed in the ITAR; and
 - l. restrict access, by means of transfer if necessary, to controlled technology to particular members of the Applicants' workforce, based on their substantive contacts, where such contacts objectively create an unacceptable risk of diversion of ITAR Controlled Material or technology; and
 - m. record and maintain a register of those employees and contractors that are permitted to access ITAR Controlled Material or work on controlled projects due to substantive contacts. Access to the register to be limited to only those employees, (including contractors' staff), contract workers and agents of the Applicants with a need to know.
- (B) This Exemption Order does not extend to any other identification, collection, storage or use of information in relation to any employee in respect of that employee's race, colour, nationality, descent or ethnic, ethno-religious or national origin. Except to the extent expressly provided for herein, this Exemption Order does not excuse, or purport to excuse, the Applicants from complying with their obligations pursuant to the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977* (NSW) or any other legislation or at common law.
- (C) The Applicants are required, prior to taking any action permitted by this Exemption Order, to provide all employees, and prospective employees with:
- i. express notice that they may be adversely affected by this exemption if they are not an Australian citizen or if they hold dual citizenship;
 - ii. a reasonable explanation in plain English of the nature of any adverse effects of such action to them; and
 - iii. information (at the time of recruitment in the case of prospective employees) about how they can apply for Australian citizenship.
- (D) In addition to the above conditions the Applicants are required to:
1. produce comprehensive anti-discrimination policies governing all aspects of the work and workforce, including management, and with particular regard to race discrimination, vilification and harassment and victimisation;

2. establish concise and comprehensive dispute resolution and grievance procedures to receive, investigate and resolve discrimination complaints and grievances and, in particular, those relating to race discrimination, vilification and harassment and victimisation;
 3. implement training programs, including at induction, to ensure that all members of the Applicants' workforce, including management, are fully informed of their rights and obligations under such policies and procedures, particularly with regard to issues of race discrimination, vilification, harassment and victimisation;
 4. ensure that all members of the workforce, including management, receive regular education and training in issues of discrimination, particularly race discrimination, vilification, harassment and victimisation;
 5. take steps to fully inform the workforce, including management, of their rights under the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977* (NSW) and, in particular, but not limited to, the complaints procedure under the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977* (NSW) and to ensure that all members of the workforce, including management, are aware of the rights of aggrieved persons to take their complaints to the Anti-Discrimination Board and through the New South Wales Civil and Administrative Tribunal;
 6. take steps to fully inform the workforce, including management, of the requirements of, and their rights and obligations under, the *Racial Discrimination Act 1975* (Cth);
 7. notify the Board if the discriminatory terms and provisions of the relevant US legislation and/or Regulations are repealed or become inoperative, so that this Exemption Order may be revoked or amended.
- (E) The Applicants are required to advise the Anti-Discrimination Board, every six months from the date of this Exemption Order, over the period specified in this Order, of:
1. The steps they have taken to comply with all the above conditions, including:
 - a. the number of job applicants rejected for ITAR purposes, including those subsequently appointed to other roles within each reporting period;
 - b. the number of employees retrenched or redeployed due to ITAR requirements and any steps taken to minimise retrenchment or redeployment, and any steps taken generally to mitigate the impact of the Applicants' responsibility under ITAR on the deployment of its workforce within each reporting period;
 - c. the number of vacancies advertised within each reporting period, including the number of such vacancies where candidates were required to satisfy ITAR related requirements.
 2. The implementation and compliance generally with the terms of this Exemption Order.
- (F) The Applicants are required to take all reasonable steps to ensure that any employees adversely affected by this Exemption Order, retain employment with the Applicants, and do not suffer a reduction in wages, salary or opportunity for advancement.
- (G) If the Applicants, in order to enable them to comply with the US Regulations or related contractual obligations associated with the US Regulations, moves a member of the workforce from one project to another, the Applicants must take reasonable steps both to explain to that person why the transfer has occurred and to avoid any race-based hostility that might result from the transfer.
- (H) Where prospective employees adversely affected by this Exemption Order would otherwise have been acceptable to the Applicants as employees, the Applicants are required to consider and, if feasible, implement reasonable and practicable alternatives to rejection, such as employment in other work or obtaining the necessary approvals under the US Regulations.
- In this Exemption Order:
- the expression "the Applicants" means BAE Systems Australia Ltd and BAE Systems Australia Defence Pty Ltd;
 - the expression "ITAR Controlled Material" means controlled defence articles, technical data and defence services which are the subject of export controls under the US Regulations.
- This Exemption is granted until 20 August 2019.

Section 125 Fares Order for Taxi Services

Determination of Maximum Fares for Taxis

Determination of the Maximum Taxi Non-Cash Payment Surcharge

I, DAVID MALCOLM STEWART, Secretary of the Department of Transport, for and on behalf of Transport for NSW pursuant to section 125 of the *Passenger Transport Act 2014*, hereby determine that:

- a) the maximum fares payable by hirers in respect of taxi services in New South Wales shall be as set out hereunder; and
- b) the maximum taxi non-cash payment surcharge in respect of taxi services in New South Wales shall be as set out hereunder.

1. Interpretation

Terms used, other than those defined hereunder, have the same meaning as they do in the *Passenger Transport Act 2014*.

‘**Country Area**’ means that part of New South Wales other than an Urban Area and an Exempt Area.

‘**Distance Rate**’ means a fixed amount payable per kilometre, as set out in clauses 3 and 4 (as the case may be), when the vehicle is travelling more than 26 kilometres per hour.

‘**Exempt Area**’ means the townships of Moama, Barham, Tocomwal, Mulwala, Barooga and Deniliquin.

‘**Hiring Charge**’ means the flag fall (or fixed charge) payable, as set out in clauses 3 and 4 (as the case may be), for the hiring of a taxi and payable at all times.

‘**Holiday Distance Rate**’ means a fixed amount payable per kilometre, as set out in clause 4, in respect of a journey commencing between 6am and 10pm on a Sunday or Public Holiday.

‘**Night Distance Rate**’ means a fixed amount payable per kilometre, calculated by applying the night-time surcharge of 20% of the Distance Rate, as set out in clauses 3 and 4 (as the case may be), when the vehicle is travelling more than 26 kilometres per hour in respect of a journey commencing between 10pm and 6am.

‘**Peak Time Hiring Charge**’ means a fixed surcharge, as set out in clause 3, payable in addition to the Hiring Charge set out in clause 3, for the hiring of a taxi licensed to operate in an Urban Area in respect of a journey commencing between 10pm on a Friday, Saturday or day before a Public Holiday and 6am on the next day.

‘**Public Holiday**’ means a day specified in section 4 of the *Public Holidays Act 2010*, any day specified by the Minister administering that Act as an additional public holiday in accordance with section 5 of that Act, or any day specified by the Minister administering that Act as a substituted day in accordance with section 6 of that Act.

‘**Tolls**’ mean all road, bridge, ferry, tunnel and airport tolls that apply to a journey and, in respect of a northbound journey over the Sydney Harbour Bridge or through the Sydney Harbour Tunnel, mean an amount equal to the toll applicable to southbound traffic at the time of the hirer’s northbound journey.

‘**Urban Area**’ means those parts of New South Wales specified in Schedule 1.

‘**Waiting Time**’ means a fixed amount payable per minute, as set out in clauses 3 and 4 (as the case may be), while vehicle speed is less than 26 km/h.

Notes in the text of this Fares Order do not form part of the Fares Order.

2. Commencement

This determination takes effect on 12 December 2014.

3. Maximum Fares in an Urban Area

The maximum fares and other arrangements payable in relation to a taxi licensed to operate in an Urban Area are as set out in this clause.

Hiring Charge:	\$3.60
Peak Time Hiring Charge:	\$2.50
Distance Rate:	\$2.19 per kilometre
Night Distance Rate:	\$2.63 per kilometre
Booking Fee:	\$2.50
Waiting Time:	94.4 cents per minute (\$56.68 per hour)

4. Maximum Fares in a Country Area

The maximum fares and other arrangements payable in relation to a taxi licensed to operate in a Country Area are as set out in this clause.

Hiring Charge:	\$4.10
Distance Rate:	\$2.26 per kilometre for the first 12 kilometres and \$3.13 per kilometre thereafter
Night Distance Rate:	\$2.71 per kilometre for the first 12 kilometres and \$3.75 per kilometre thereafter
Holiday Distance Rate:	\$2.71 per kilometre for the first 12 kilometres and \$3.75 per kilometre thereafter
Booking Fee:	\$1.20
Waiting Time:	96.0 cents per minute (\$57.65 per hour)

5. Tolls

Tolls are payable in addition to the authorised fare in relation to a journey in a taxi licensed to operate in either an Urban Area or a Country Area.

6. Maxi-cabs

An amount of up to 150% of the fare and other arrangements payable in accordance with clauses 3 and 4 (as the case may

be), may be demanded by the driver of a maxi-cab licensed to operate in either an Urban Area or a Country Area, if:

- when a taxi is booked, a maxi-cab is requested; or
- a maxi-cab is hired from a taxi-zone or street and there are 5 or more adult passengers.

This clause does not apply:

- in respect of a multiple hiring; or
- if the maxi-cab is booked for a group of passengers which includes a passenger using a wheelchair, unless the person who made the booking requested a taxi with seating for 5 or more adult passengers, including the passenger using a wheelchair.

In this clause, ‘**maxi-cab**’ means a taxi that has seating accommodation for 6 or more adult persons in addition to the driver.

7. Multiple Hirings

An amount of 75% of the fare and other arrangements payable in accordance with clauses 3 and 4 (as the case may be) may be demanded by the driver of a taxi licensed to operate in either an Urban Area or a Country Area and payable by each hirer of the taxi provided:

- all of the hirers commence the hiring of the taxi at the same time, and
- each of the hirers agrees that the driver may accept the other hirings, and
- all of the hirers are travelling to destinations in the same general locality or the same general direction.

8. Exempt Area

This determination does not apply to a taxi licensed to operate in an Exempt Area.

Note: Exempt Area is defined in Clause 1.

9. Taxi non-cash payment surcharge

The maximum amount payable for a taxi non-cash payment surcharge is 5% inclusive of GST.

The following rounding rule applies when determining the amount payable for a taxi non-cash payment surcharge: round down to the nearest whole cent below half a cent; round up to the nearest whole cent from half a cent.

Note: Under section 126 of the *Passenger Transport Act 2014* a taxi non-cash payment surcharge means a fee or charge (however calculated):

- added to the amount otherwise payable by a hirer of a taxi because the amount payable for the hire of the taxi is paid wholly or partly by the use of a debit, credit, pre-paid or charge card, or
- payable by all or any of the owner or driver of, or holder of a licence for, a taxi or the operator of a taxi service using a taxi because an amount payable for the hire of the taxi is paid wholly or partly by the use of a debit, credit, pre-paid or charge card.

Note: The taxi non-cash payment surcharge operates as a cap on all surcharges that may be applied because the amount payable in respect of the taxi hire is paid by debit, credit, pre-paid or charge card. For example, if the amount payable in respect of the taxi hire is \$100, then the maximum (and only) taxi non-cash payment surcharge will be \$5.

10. Revocation of Previous Determinations

All previous Determinations made under section 60A of the *Passenger Transport Act 1990* are revoked.

1. This instrument has been prepared under the Act by CPA Australia whose business address is Level 20, 28 Freshwater Place, Southbank Victoria 3006, and amends CPA Australia's Scheme as follows:
 - (a) In Clause 1.1, replace "Vic" with "Victoria".
 - (b) Renumber the Scheme Clause 2.2 as Clause 2.3.
 - (c) After Clause 2.1, insert a new Clause 2.2 as follows:

"2.2. This Scheme does not apply to holders of Australian financial planning services licences and their authorised representatives and employees, unless such licences are only held pursuant to a Limited Australian Financial Services Licence or pursuant to regulation 7.1.29A of the *Corporations Regulations*."

- (d) In footnote 2, insert "to" between the words "persons whom" on the last line.
- (e) In Clause 3.6 (c), replace "3.5" with "3.7".
- (f) In Clause 3.9, delete ", that is, Clauses 3.2 to 3.4".
- (e) In Clause 3.10, delete ", that is, Clauses 3.5 and 3.6".
- (f) In Clause 4.1, replace the definition of "Category 3 services" with –

"Category 3 services" means any services provided by a participant in the performance of his, her or its occupation, which are not Category 1 services or Category 2 services.
- (g) In Clause 4.1, for the definition of "principal(s)", replace "clauses 3.3, 3.4 and 3.5" with "clauses 3.3, 3.5 and 3.7".

Commencement

2. The amendment shall commence on 1 December 2014 or the day after its publication in the *Government Gazette* of New South Wales, whichever being the later.
