HERITAGE (LORD HOWE ISLAND EXEMPTION) ORDER 2014

Order under Section 57 (2)
to Grant Exemption from Approval
for Specific Activities at Lord Howe Island

I, the Minister for Heritage, on the recommendation of the Heritage Council of New South Wales, make the following order under section 57 (2) of the *Heritage Act 1977* (“the Act”).

1 Name of order

This Order is the Heritage (Lord Howe Island Exemption) Order 2014.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day that it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Repeal the previous order

The Order made on 17 October 2005 published in Gazette No 132 of 28 October 2005 at page 9223 is repealed.

5 Grant of exemption

An exemption is granted from section 57 (1) of the Act to a person carrying out any activity described in Schedule B in relation to the item described in Schedule A.

6 Exclusions from the grant

This Order does not grant an exemption from the requirement to obtain an excavation permit under section 139 of the Act for the disturbance of relics.

SCHEDULE A

The item known as the Lord Howe Island Group listed in the State Heritage Register (number 00970) comprising the land described in section 3 (1) of the *Lord Howe Island Act 1953*.

SCHEDULE B

1. Development permissible under the *Lord Howe Island Local Environmental Plan 2010*, other than development that requires consent under clause 39, provided any approval required under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* has been obtained.

5. Work, activity or use of land by the Lord Howe Island Board or other public authority that involves any of the following:
 - (a) pest management;
 - (b) wood collection;
 - (c) maintenance and re-surfacing of roads;
 - (d) maintenance of visitor facilities;
 - (e) erosion control measures;
 - (f) environmental protection works.

6. Erection, removal and modification of signage for information, interpretation or directional purposes by or on behalf of the Lord Howe Island Board or other public authority.
7. Maintenance, repainting, cleaning of buildings, works, public services and utilities and landscape features including but not limited to erosion control, road and path resurfacing and routine horticultural maintenance.
8. Repair (such as refixing and patching) or replacement of missing, damaged or deteriorating fabric of buildings, works, public services, utilities and landscape features which:
 - (a) matches the existing fabric in appearance, material, and method of affixation;
 - (b) does not involve damage to or removal of significant fabric; and
 - (c) does not extend to the cumulative replacement of large amounts or a high proportion of the fabric of an item.

- (b) where the application is made before the Commencement Date:
 - (a) the possession of qualifications or the passing of examinations; and
 - (b) the possession of experience,

specified in the instrument dealing with the same matters as this Instrument which was in force at the time the relevant application was made.

The reference to a “*Diploma*” in Item 8 in Table C of Schedule 1, does not include a Diploma of: Building; Construction; Construction Management; Construction Economics; Applied Science (Building); Structural Engineering; or Quantity Surveying. On every other occasion the term “*Diploma*” is used in this Instrument it is to be given its ordinary meaning;

“*Experience*” means experience gained by the applicant as:

- (a) an employee of; or
- (b) a holder of a supervisor certificate and as a nominated supervisor for the contractor licence held by; or
- (c) a holder of an endorsed contractor licence contracted to; or
- (d) a holder of a supervisor certificate in the capacity of a nominated supervisor for a contractor licence held by an individual, partnership or corporation contracted to,

the holder of a contractor licence authorising the holder to do the class of residential building work in which the experience was gained (“*the Work*”), where the applicant, during the relevant period, was:

- supervised and directed in the doing of the Work by the holder of an endorsed contractor licence or supervisor certificate authorising its holder to supervise the Work; and
- remunerated with money in accordance with law for the Work which the applicant carried out;

“*Registered Training Organisation*” has the same meaning as in the *National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011* (Cth);

the reference to “*Schedule 1*” includes the tables in Schedule 1;

“*TAFE*” means the New South Wales Technical and Further Education Commission.
