NOXIOUS WEEDS (EXEMPTIONS) ORDER 2015

under the Noxious Weeds Act 1993

I, SCOTT HANSEN, Director General, Department of Primary Industries, with the delegated authority of the Minister for Primary Industries in pursuance of section 66 of the *Noxious Weeds Act 1993*, and in pursuance of section 32A of that Act, make the following Order.

Explanatory note

This Order is made under section 32A of the *Noxious Weeds Act 1993* and provides exemptions to mainland New South Wales from certain obligations and offences for those plants declared as Control Class 2 noxious weeds on Lord Howe Island only. Lord Howe Island is a World Heritage Site with a unique flora and fauna that differs markedly from mainland New South Wales. Provisions of the *Noxious Weeds Act 1993* are used to help protect the environment of Lord Howe Island from invasive weeds. A number of plants that occur naturally to or are innocuous on mainland New South Wales are highly invasive on Lord Howe Island and have been declared as Control Class 2 noxious weeds under section 7 of the *Noxious Weeds Act 1993*.

NOXIOUS WEEDS (EXEMPTIONS) ORDER 2015

under the
Noxious Weeds Act 1993

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Noxious Weeds (Exemptions) Order 2015*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the date it is published in the *NSW Government Gazette*.

3 Interpretation

In this Order:

Lord Howe Island has the same meaning as *Island* in the *Lord Howe Island Act 1953*.

the Act means the *Noxious Weeds Act 1993*.

Note: *notifiable weed*, *noxious weed* and *weed control order* all have the same meaning as in the Act.

4 Application of this Order

This Order applies to the plants specified in Column 2 of the Table, each of which is a Class 2 noxious weed only on Lord Howe Island (and not elsewhere in New South Wales).

Table – Class 2 noxious weeds only on Lord Howe Island (notifiable weeds only on Lord Howe Island)

Notes:

1. Class 2 is a weed control class that may be applied to a plant by a weed control order made under section 7 of the Act. The weed control class “Class 2” was applied to the noxious weeds in the above Table only on Lord Howe Island by the *Noxious Weeds (Weed Control) Order 2014* made under section 7 of the Act and published in NSW Government Gazette No. 23 of 28 February 2014 at pages 734–845.
2. Section 8 (3) of the Act provides that a noxious weed that is classified as a Class 1, Class 2 or Class 5 noxious weed is referred to in the Act as a ***notifiable weed***.
3. The common name of a plant specified in Column 1 of the Table is for information purposes only and does not limit the description of the plant in Column 2 of the Table.

5 Exemptions relating to weeds notifiable only on Lord Howe Island

- (1) Pursuant to section 32A (1) of the Act, all persons, premises, machinery and equipment are exempted from the operation, in any part of New South Wales other than Lord Howe Island, of sections 29, 32 and 40 of the Act in relation to any Lord Howe Island notifiable weed or any Lord Howe Island notifiable weed material.
- (2) Pursuant to sections 32A (1) and 32A (2) of the Act and subject to the condition set out in subclause (3) below, all persons are exempted from the operation, in any part of New South Wales other than Lord Howe Island, of section 28 (1) of the Act in relation to any Lord Howe Island notifiable weed or any Lord Howe Island notifiable weed material.
- (3) The exemption set out in subclause (2) above does not apply if any of the following items is being sold or purchased for dispatch or distribution to Lord Howe Island:
 - (a) any Lord Howe Island notifiable weed;
 - (b) any Lord Howe Island notifiable weed material;
 - (c) any animal or thing which has on it, or contains, any Lord Howe Island notifiable weed or any Lord Howe Island notifiable weed material.
- (4) In this clause:

Lord Howe Island notifiable weed means any plant specified in the Table to clause 4.

Lord Howe Island notifiable weed material means any seed or other part of a Lord Howe Island notifiable weed.

- (19) Upon termination or forfeiture of the lease the Commissioner may direct that the former lessee shall remove any structure or material from the land at his own cost and without compensation. Where such a direction has been given the former lessee shall leave the land in a clean and tidy condition free from rubbish and debris.
- (20) The lessee shall not erect any fence on the leased area or interfere with or impede the use of any existing track or road on the leased land or adjacent to the leased land, except with the permission of the Commissioner.
- (21) The Crown shall not be responsible to the lessee or the lessee's successors in title for the provision of access to the land leased.
- (22) The lessee shall, within such time as may be specified by the Commissioner take such steps and measures as the Commissioner shall direct to destroy vermin and such animals and weeds as may, under any Act, from time to time be declared (by declaration covering the land leased) noxious in the Gazette and shall keep the land free of such vermin and noxious animals and weeds during the currency of the lease to the satisfaction of the Commissioner.
- (23) The lessee shall be responsible for the repair and maintenance of any subsidence which may occur as a result of the previous mining activity on the lease area.
- (24) If the lessee is an Australian registered company than the following conditions shall apply:
- i/ The Lessee will advise the Commissioner of the name, address and telephone number of the Lessee's company secretary, that person being a person nominated as a representative of the company in respect of any dealings to be had with the company. The Lessee agrees to advise the Commissioner of any changes in these details.

- ii/ Any change in the shareholding of the Lessee's company which alters its effective control of the lease from that previously known to the Commissioner shall be deemed an assignment by the Lessee.
- iii/ Where any notice or other communication is required to be served or given or which may be convenient to be served or given under or in connection with this lease it shall be sufficiently executed if it is signed by the company secretary.
- iv/ A copy of the company's annual financial balance sheet or other financial statement which gives a true and fair view of the company's state of affairs as at the end of each financial year is to be submitted to the Commissioner upon request.

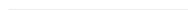

- 3) pursuant to section 5 (5) of the Act, do hereby specify that for the purposes of section 7 (c) of the Act that the following procedure applies to the giving of notice of a person's intention to provide health services in the State:
 - a. notice is taken to have been given in respect any visiting health practitioner, being medical practitioners and physiotherapists, whose name was provided to the Ministry of Health, in relation to this special event, on or before the date of this order; and

Section 109

Declaration of Mental Health Facility

I, Dr MARY FOLEY, Secretary of the NSW Ministry of Health, pursuant to section 109 of the *Mental Health Act 2007*, do hereby:

- (a) DECLARE the following premises to be a declared mental health facility for the purposes of the *Mental Health Act 2007*:
 - The Emergency Department of Lithgow Hospital, located within Main Building, Lithgow Hospital, corner of the Great Western Highway and Col Drewe Drive, Lithgow NSW 2790; and
- (b) DECLARE this facility to be designated as a “mental health emergency assessment” facility; and
- (c) RESTRICT this facility to the provision of acute assessment functions, where a patient can be held in anticipation of discharge should their clinical condition resolve rapidly, or transferred to a declared mental health facility of the “mental health assessment and inpatient treatment” class if required, in accordance with all provisions of the *Mental Health Act 2007*, with the exception of:
 - i. Chapter 2;
 - ii. Division 1 of Part 3 of Chapter 3;
 - iii. Sections 57, 58 and 59 of Division 2 of Part 3 of Chapter 3; and
 - iv. Division 3 of Part 3 of Chapter 3.
