PLANT DISEASES (CUCUMBER GREEN MOTTLE MOSAIC VIRUS) ORDER 2016

under the

PLANT DISEASES ACT 1924

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Plant Diseases (Cucumber Green Mottle Mosaic Virus) Order 2016*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the date it is published in the *NSW Government Gazette*.

3 Interpretation

In this Order:

Area Freedom Certificate means a certificate:

- (a) issued by an officer responsible for plant biosecurity in the State or Territory; and
- (b) certifying that the State or Territory, or part of the State or Territory, is free from the disease, CGMMV.

Certification Assurance Arrangement means an arrangement approved by the Department of Primary Industries which enables a business accredited under the arrangement to certify that certain quarantine requirements have been satisfied for movement of certain host plant material to interstate and/or intrastate markets.

Note: An example of an approved Certification Assurance Arrangement is a Compliance Agreement or the Interstate Certification Assurance (ICA) Scheme.

CGMMV means cucumber green mottle mosaic virus.

host plant material means any plant or part of a plant (except for fruit) belonging to the family Cucurbitaceae.

Plant Health Assurance Certificate means a document (known as a Plant Health Assurance Certificate) issued by a business accredited under a Certification Assurance Arrangement.

Plant Health Certificate means a document (known as a Plant Health Certificate) issued by:

- (a) an inspector or a person authorised pursuant to section 11 (3) of the Act; or
- (b) a person authorised to issue such a certificate under a law of another State or Territory that relates to plant biosecurity.

the Act means the *Plant Diseases Act 1924*.

used agricultural machinery means any machinery or equipment that has been used in the growing, harvesting or processing of host plant material, or the fruit of host plant material.

used packaging means any covering or packaging that has contained host plant material.

Note: *covering* or *package* and *inspector* all have the same meaning as in the Act.

4 Revocation of Plant Diseases (Cucumber Green Mottle Mosaic Virus) Order (No 2) 2014

Pursuant to sections 4 and 3 (2) (a) of the Act, the *Plant Diseases (Cucumber Green Mottle Mosaic Virus) Order (No 2) 2014* (having the Department's reference O-448) published in *NSW Government Gazette* No 119 on 12 December 2014 at pages 4450 to 4451 is revoked, as is any Order revived as a result of this revocation.

5 Prohibition on the introduction of CGMMV

Pursuant to section 4 of the Act, the importation, introduction or bringing of anything that is infected with CGMMV into New South Wales is prohibited.

6 Regulation of the movement of host plant material

Pursuant to section 4 (1) of the Act, host plant material must not be imported, introduced or brought into New South Wales unless:

- (a) an Area Freedom Certificate is currently in force in respect of the State or Territory, or part of the State or Territory, where the host plant material (or the plant from which host plant material was derived) was grown; or
- (b) subclauses (i) and (ii) below are satisfied:
 - (i) the host plant material is grown, labelled and certified in accordance with any conditions prescribed by a Certification Assurance Arrangement; and
 - (ii) the host plant material is accompanied by a Plant Health Assurance Certificate or a Plant Health Certificate certifying that the conditions in subclause (b) (i) above are satisfied.

7 Regulation of the movement of used agricultural machinery and used packaging

Pursuant to section 4 (1) of the Act, used agricultural machinery or used packaging must not be imported, introduced or brought into New South Wales unless:

- (a) an area freedom certificate is currently in force in respect of the State or Territory, or part of the State or Territory, in which the used agricultural machinery or used packaging was last used; or
- (b) subclauses (i) and (ii) below are satisfied:
 - (i) the used agricultural machinery or used packaging is free of soil and organic matter; and
 - (ii) the used agricultural machinery or used packaging is accompanied by a Plant Health Certificate certifying that the conditions in subclause (b) (i) above are satisfied.

8 Regulation of the movement of soil that has contained host plant material

Pursuant to section 4 (1) of the Act, soil that has contained host plant material must not be imported, introduced or brought into New South Wales unless an area freedom certificate is currently in force in respect of the State or Territory, or part of the State or Territory, from which the soil that has contained host plant material was derived.

Certification Assurance Arrangement means an arrangement approved by the Department of Primary Industries which enables a business accredited under the arrangement to certify that certain quarantine requirements have been satisfied for movement of certain host plant material to interstate and/or intrastate markets.

4 Regulation of the movement of host plant material

(1) Pursuant to section 4 (1) of the Act, host plant material must not be imported, introduced or brought into New South Wales unless;

- (a) an area freedom certificate is currently in force in respect of the State or Territory, or part of the State or Territory, where the host plant material was grown; or
- (b) the host plant material is accompanied by a Plant Health Certificate or a Plant Health Assurance Certificate certifying that:
 - a. it has been treated with an APVMA approved insecticide for the control of scale in accordance with all label and APVMA permit directions for the control of scale insects; and
 - b. it has been inspected at the rate of:
 - i. a minimum of 2% of the consignment; or
 - ii. 600 units
 whichever is the greater, and no pyriform scale has been detected.

CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ACT 1986

District Court Criminal Practice Note 12

Readiness Hearings

Commencement

1. This Practice Note commences on 29 April 2016.

Application

2. This Practice Note applies to proceedings on indictment with an estimated duration of six or more weeks.

Definitions

3. In this Practice Note:

“accused person” includes an Australian legal practitioner representing an accused person

“court” means the District Court

“Judge” has the same meaning as in the *District Court Act 1973*

“pre-trial conference” means a conference held under s 140 of the *Criminal Procedure Act 1986*

“pre-trial hearing” means a hearing held under s 139 of the *Criminal Procedure Act 1986*

“prosecutor” has the same meaning as in the *Criminal Procedure Act 1986*

“readiness hearing” means a hearing to ascertain the readiness of the trial to proceed on the allocated trial date

Introduction

4. The purpose of this Practice Note is to reduce delays in proceedings on indictment with an estimated duration of six or more weeks by enabling the court to order the prosecutor and the accused person to attend one or more readiness hearings.
5. This Practice Note responds to the provisions of the *Criminal Procedure Act 1986*, Part 3, Division 3 (‘Case management provisions and other provisions to reduce delays in proceedings’).

Process

6. At the first mention of proceedings in the court or at any other time, the court may order the prosecutor and the accused person to attend one or more readiness hearings before the court.
7. During the readiness hearing, the court may make any such orders, determinations or findings, or give such directions or rulings, as it thinks appropriate to identify the issues in contention and for the efficient management and conduct of the trial.
8. Case management measures available to the court during the readiness hearing include the ordering of pre-trial hearings, pre-trial conferences and further pre-trial disclosure. The court has discretion in determining which (if any) measures are suitable in the proceedings concerned.
9. The following persons must be present during the readiness hearing:
 - a. the prosecutor,
 - b. the Australian legal practitioner representing the accused person, and
 - c. the accused person, if not represented by an Australian legal practitioner and not in custody.
10. The accused person is not required and is not expected to be present at the readiness hearing provided he or she is represented by an Australian legal practitioner.
11. The readiness hearing will be vacated and the matter listed for directions in the arraignment list where the accused person is not represented by an Australian legal practitioner and is in custody.
12. The prosecutor and the accused person’s legal representatives are to be present at the readiness hearing with full knowledge of the state of the proceedings.
13. Readiness hearings will normally be fixed at least six weeks prior to the date set for trial and held in courtroom 21A, Level 21, John Maddison Tower, 86 Goulburn Street, Sydney, NSW 2000.
