BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION REGULATION 2017

Public exhibition of proposed Biodiversity Conservation Regulation 2017 and related products

NOTICE is given, in accordance with Section 5 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, of the intention to make the *Biodiversity Conservation Regulation 2017*.

The regulation is being progressed as part of the Land Management and Biodiversity Conservation reforms. A draft of the proposed regulation has been released for public comment.

The object of the proposed regulation is to prescribe further details to support the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* including details for:

- the protection of animals and plants
- areas of outstanding biodiversity value
- listing criteria for threatened species and ecological communities
- provisions relating to private land conservation agreements
- the Biodiversity Offsets Scheme, and biodiversity assessment and approvals under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*
- the biodiversity certification of land
- public consultation and public registers
- the Biodiversity Conservation Trust
- regulatory compliance mechanisms and criminal and civil proceedings

Detail

Removal and construction works will be conducted on the existing Stingray Creek Bridge, Camden Haven, which will affect safe navigation of the Stingray Creek. Vessel operators should be aware that crane lifting operations and work vessel movements will be conducted in the area.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the above times and will be created on the Stingray Creek 100 metres of either side of the Stingray Creek Bridge.

The exclusion zone will be marked by the presence of yellow aqua buoys.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.

All vessel operators and persons using the waters specified should keep a proper lookout, keep well clear of the works and exercise extreme caution when navigating near the exclusion zone.

A 'transit lane' will be established through the exclusion zone - and under the bridge - and will be marked by the presence of port (red) and starboard (green) buoys and reflective markers on the bridge pylons, authorising local vessels to pass through the creek. At times where lifting operations are conducted as part of the works, the transit lane will be monitored and patrolled by control vessels who will advise vessel operators not to enter.

SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS apply to vessels navigating the transit lane. Vessels navigating the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots, must produce no wash, and must comply with any direction given by an authorised officer.

The speed restriction in the transit lane will be indicated on signage and on buoys.

At times, navigable spans under the existing Grafton Bridge will be closed to navigation.

Monday 27 March 2017 to Sunday 31 March 2019.

Detail

Construction of a new Pacific Highway Bridge, immediately downstream of the existing Harwood Bridge will occur for a period of approximately 2 years, affecting safe navigation on the Clarence River.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the construction works and will be created on the Clarence River 200 metres of either side of the existing Harwood Bridge.

The exclusion zone will be marked by yellow special marks (yellow buoys), specified at intervals of approximately 50 metres, and barges fitted with lights at night.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.

All vessel operators and persons using the waters near the zone should keep a proper lookout, keep well clear of the works and exercise extreme caution when navigating near the exclusion zone paying particular attention to construction work vessels, barges, anchoring cables, lighting & day shapes and any advisory signage.

A 'transit lane' will be established through the exclusion zone - and under the Harwood Bridge - and will be marked by the presence of port (red) and starboard (green) buoys, which will be lit at night, authorising vessels to pass through the river.

At times, navigable spans under the Harwood Bridge will be closed to navigation. "Channel blocked" lights and shapes will be displayed as appropriate.

Note: The main bridge lifting span of the Harwood Bridge will be closed to navigation. This will require the transit lane to be moved for approximately 6 weeks while maintenance work is done. During this maintenance work, the transit lane will comprise a temporary channel through Span 17, marked by navigation lateral marks with a 8.534 metre vertical clearance measure from the Mean High Water Spring (MHWS) and a 38.743 metre horizontal clearance between pile caps.

Once this maintenance is complete, the transit lane will be moved back under the lifting span.

SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS apply to vessels navigating the transit lane. Vessels navigating the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots, must produce no wash, and must comply with any direction given by an authorised officer. Vessels must not anchor in the transit lane unless authorised.

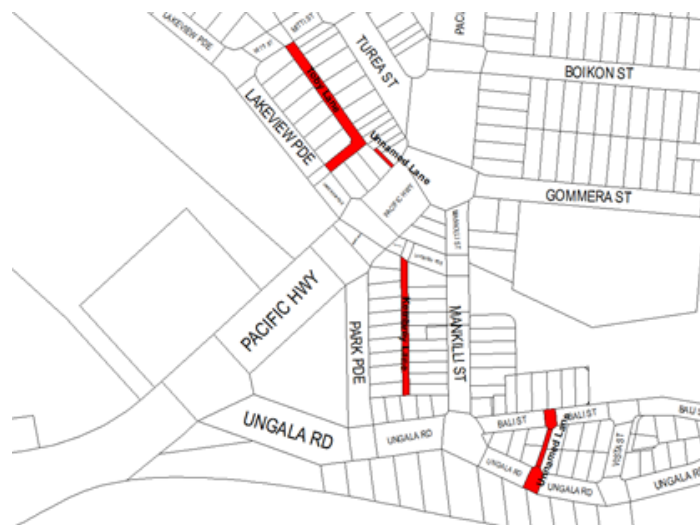

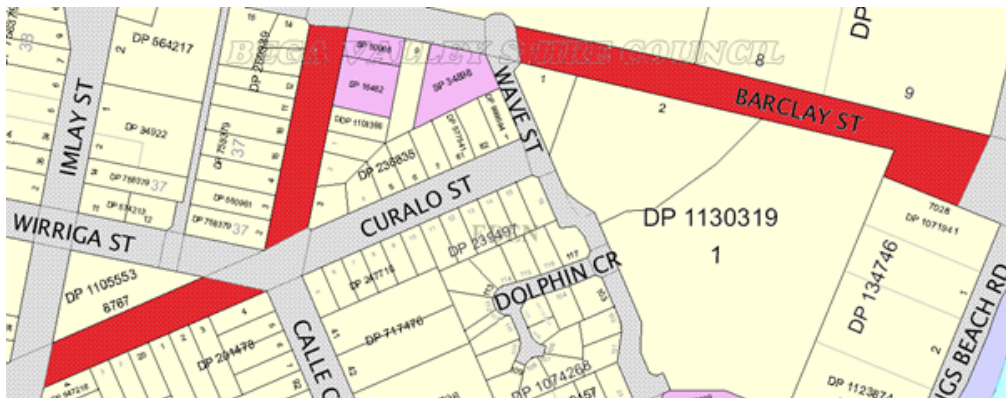

All declarations and assurance opinions are to be submitted to the Monitor by the close of business on 15 November 2017, or otherwise by agreement with the Monitor.

- (b) making any claim in relation to, or alleging loss caused by or misconduct by any person in relation to:
 - (i) orders made against him by the Land and Environment Court in proceedings 41243 of 2004; or
 - (ii) the conduct by The Hills Shire Council or any other person in the course of proceedings between Milovan (Michael) Stankovic and the Hills Shire Council; or
 - (iii) the sequestration order made on 12 May 2009; or
 - (iv) the sale of the Kellyville Property.
- (2) Proceedings 2016/00166961 in the New South Wales Land and Environment Court are stayed.
- (3) The usual order as to costs is that they follow the event. That would be an order that Mr Stankovic is to bear the Council's costs as agreed or assessed. Unless the parties approach to be heard on the question of costs within 14 days, that will be the Court's order.

The Emergency Services Levy Insurance Monitor publishes the following order under Section 30 of the *Emergency Services Levy Insurance Monitor Act 2016* ("the Act"), as amended by the *Fire and Emergency Services Levy Act 2017*.

The order requires an insurance company (as defined in the Act) to provide certain information under Section 30(1) of the Act. The information must be provided under one of the following two options:

- Option A applies to insurance companies who do not, or are unable to, provide a renewal premium comparison within the renewal notice issued to policyholders for policies commencing from 1 July 2017.
- Option B applies to insurance companies who can provide, or will be providing, a renewal premium comparison, consistent with the comparative information in option A, within the renewal notice issued to policyholders for policies commencing from 1 July 2017.

Guidance will be published on the Insurance Monitor's website to assist insurance companies with determining the scope and application of the information.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 30 OF THE EMERGENCY SERVICES LEVY INSURANCE MONITOR ACT 2016
