## GOVERNMENT NOTICES

### PASSENGER TRANSPORT (GENERAL) REGULATION 2017

#### Clause 69 Definitions

#### Approved Payment Device

#### Notice

TRANSPORT FOR NSW, pursuant to Clause 69 of the *Passenger Transport (General) Regulation 2017*, does by this Notice:

1. **REVOKE** the Approved Payment Device Notice published in NSW Government Gazette No. 76 on 6 July 2017.
2. **APPROVE** the following classes of payment devices as an approved payment device to be used as a smartcard for the payment of fares by scanning at a smartcard reader designated for use by a smartcard of that kind:
  - (a) A contactless credit card that operates on the American Express Companion Card payment system subject to a designation issued by the Reserve Bank of Australia pursuant to the *Payment Systems (Regulation) Act 1998* (Cth);
  - (b) A contactless credit card or debit card that operates on the MasterCard system, the MasterCard network card system or the Debit MasterCard debit card system, in each case subject to a designation issued by the Reserve Bank of Australia pursuant to the *Payment Systems (Regulation) Act 1998* (Cth);
  - (c) A contactless credit card or debit card that operates on the VISA system, the VISA network card system or Visa debit system, in each case subject to a designation issued by the Reserve Bank of Australia pursuant to the *Payment Systems (Regulation) Act 1998* (Cth);
  - (d) A smartphone or other device that emulates a credit card or debit card referred to in (a), (b) or (c) above to enable payments to be made.

This Notice takes effect on 12 March 2018.

#### Clause 76 (1) (c) Designation of Routes

#### Order

#### Ferry Services Operated by Harbour City Ferries

Transport for NSW, pursuant to clause 76 of the *Passenger Transport (General) Regulation 2017*, does by this Order designate each of the following routes operated by Harbour City Ferries as a route for which an approved payment device, being a kind of smartcard, may be used:

1. F1- Manly service,
2. F2- Taronga Zoo service,
3. F3 – Parramatta River service,
4. F4 – Cross Harbour service,
5. F5 – Neutral Bay service,
6. F6 – Mosman Bay service,
7. F7 – Double Bay service,
8. F8 – Cockatoo Island service.

#### Revocation of previous Order

The Order designating the Manly Ferry Service as a route for which an approved payment device may be used, published on 6 July 2017 in NSW Government Gazette No 76 at page 3613 is revoked by this Order.
