PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT OPERATIONS ACT 1997

Order granting exemption under section 284

Preamble

This order grants Armidale Regional Council an exemption under s 284 of the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* (POEO Act) from holding an environment protection licence for the receipt of over 5,000 tonnes of general solid and asbestos waste from a natural disaster (bushfires) which occurred on the Tingha Plateau in February 2019.

Background

- a) The Tingha Plateau and Bruxner Hwy bushfires were declared as Section 44 Natural Disasters under the *Rural Fires Act 1997*.
- b) Receipt of unforeseen bushfire generated waste at the Tingha Landfill will mean that the Armidale Regional Council would need to hold an environment protection licence for what is a 'one-off' event when it normally does not require a licence for this landfill. However, the community has been using the Tingha Landfill to dispose of bushfire waste, and there is a need to maintain this essential service over the next 6 to 12 months.
- c) This exemption gives Armidale Regional Council as the owner and operator of the Tingha Landfill an exemption from the requirement to hold an environment protection licence under Schedule 1 of the POEO Act. This exemption will allow the Tingha landfill site to accept waste generated by the 'Tingha Plateau' bushfires in February 2019 which will exceed the licence threshold.
- d) The Tingha Landfill has sufficient space available for the construction of one-off asbestos waste disposal cells that will comply with the requirements of the *Protection of the Environment Operations (Waste) Regulation 2014* (Clause 80) as well as additional general solid waste capacity.
- e) Armidale Regional Council will provide additional resources to ensure the immediate, daily and final cover requirements are met as part of the bushfire recovery process.

Exemption

- 1) By this Order the Environment Protection Authority (EPA), with the approval of the Board of the EPA, in the circumstances where:
 - (i) the EPA is satisfied that it is not practicable to comply with the relevant provision or provisions, by enforcing the conditions of clauses 39(f), and
 - (ii) the EPA is satisfied that non-compliance with the provision or provisions will not have any significant adverse effect on public health, property or the environment, and
 - (iii) the Board of the EPA approves the granting of the exemption
 grants to Armidale Regional Council an exemption from holding an environment protection licence to receive more than 5,000 tonnes of bushfire related waste at Tingha Landfill.
- 2) In particular, Armidale Regional Council is exempted from complying with the following provisions of cl 39(f) of Schedule 1 of the POEO Act referred to in Table 1:

Table 1

Clause	Requirements from which the occupier is exempt
39	(f) sites that are outside the regulated area, but only if: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) the site is owned by and operated by or on behalf of a local council, and (ii) the site was in existence immediately before 28 April 2008 and was not required to be licensed before that date, and (iii) details required under clause 47 of the <i>Protection of the Environment Operations (Waste) Regulation 2005</i> were provided, in relation to the site, before 28 April 2008, and (iv) the site receives from offsite less than 5,000 tonnes per year of waste, and (v) that waste has been generated outside the regulated area and consists only of general solid waste (putrescible), general solid waste (non-putrescible), clinical and related waste, asbestos waste, grease trap waste or waste tyres (or any combination of them).

- 3) This exemption takes effect from the date the order is published in the NSW Government Gazette unless otherwise varied or revoked. The order may be varied or revoked under s 284 of the Act.

Conditions

- 4) This exemption is granted under s 284 of the POEO Act subject to the following conditions:
- a. This exemption only applies to Armidale Regional Council for the disposal of waste to land at the Tingha Landfill at Kempton Road, Tingha (Real Property Details – Lots 77, 121, 122, 123 of DP42110); and
 - b. The disposal of waste to land must not exceed 10,000 tonnes or 10,000 cubic metres, whichever is less, for the 12-month period commencing from the date of approval.

Term of Exemption

- 5) This exemption ceases to apply 12 months from the date of approval.

PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT OPERATIONS (WASTE) REGULATION 2014

Recovered Fines Alternative Daily Cover specifications

The following requirements apply to recovered fines received at a scheduled waste disposal facility for application to land as daily cover in accordance with the requirements of clause 12(7)(c) of the *Protection of the Environment Operations (Waste) Regulation 2014 (Waste Regulation)*.

Recovered fines material description	<p>The recovered fines must be a soil or sand substitute derived from the processing of construction waste as defined in Part 8A of the Waste Regulation and must meet the following 5 attributes at the time it is received at the scheduled waste disposal facility:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.1. general solid waste (non-putrescible) – the recovered fines must be classified as general solid waste (non-putrescible) based on the chemical assessment in accordance with the <i>Waste Classification Guidelines Part 1: Classifying waste, EPA 2014</i> (Attribute 1); 1.2. less than 50 millimetres particle size – the recovered fines must only comprise particles that are less than 50 millimetres in diameter (Attribute 2); 1.3. 25% less than 2.36 millimetres – 25% by weight of the recovered fines must comprise particles less than 2.36 millimetres in diameter (Attribute 3); 1.4. less than 4% physical contaminants – the recovered fines must not contain more than 4% total by weight, in any combination, of metal, glass, ceramics, plaster and other friable material, rubber, plastic, paper, cloth, paint, wood or other vegetable matter (Attribute 4); and 1.5. no asbestos – the recovered fines must not contain asbestos (Attribute 5).

Sampling and testing of recovered fines requirements</p>	<p>The scheduled waste facility supplying the recovered fines to a scheduled waste disposal facility for application to land as daily cover:</p> <p>2.1 must prepare and maintain an accurate written sampling plan documenting the facility's sample preparation, handling and storage procedures to give effect to the requirements of this specification;</p> <p>2.2 must undertake chemical testing to ensure the recovered fines are classified as general solid waste (non-putrescible) in accordance with <i>Waste Classification Guidelines Part 1: Classifying waste EPA 2014</i>;</p> <p>2.3 must undertake batch sampling by collecting 3 samples from every 2000 tonnes (or any quantity that is less than 2000 tonnes) of the recovered fines to be supplied, and test each sample for Attribute 2 and Attribute 3 using NSW Transport Roads & Maritime Services <i>Test Method T107 Fine particle distribution of road construction materials (by dry sieving)</i>;</p> <p>2.4 must undertake batch sampling by collecting 3 samples from every 2000 tonnes (or any quantity that is less than 2000 tonnes) of the recovered fines to be supplied, and test each sample for Attribute 4 using the NSW Transport Roads & Maritime Services <i>Test Method T276 Foreign materials content of recycled crushed concrete</i>;</p> <p>2.5 must cause all samples to be tested by analytical laboratories accredited by the National Association of Testing Authorities (NATA); and</p> <p>2.6 must ensure the test results of all samples are validated as compliant with the attributes listed in section 1 of this specification.</p>

Statement of compliance</p>	<p>Each delivery of recovered fines supplied to a scheduled waste disposal facility for application to land as daily cover must be accompanied by a statement of compliance issued by the scheduled waste facility supplying the recovered fines certifying that the recovered fines the subject of the delivery:</p> <p>3.1 have been sampled and tested in accordance with the requirements listed in section 2 of this specification; and</p> <p>3.2 the recovered fines the subject of the delivery comply with the Attribute requirements listed in section 1 of this specification.</p>

under the
Biosecurity Act 2015

I, Bruce M Christie, Deputy Director General Biosecurity & Food Safety NSW, in exercise of delegated authority under the *Biosecurity Act 2015*, in pursuance of section 62 of the *Biosecurity Act 2015*, reasonably believing it is necessary to prevent and eliminate the biosecurity risk posed by the spread of the weed *Asystasia gangetica* (Chinese violet), make the following Control Order.

Explanatory note This Control Order is made under section 62 of the *Biosecurity Act 2015*. The object of this Control Order is to eliminate the weed *Asystasia gangetica* (Chinese violet) within New South Wales.

Biosecurity (Chinese violet) Control Order 2019

under the
Biosecurity Act 2015

1. Name of Order

This Control Order is the *Biosecurity (Chinese violet) Control Order 2019*.

2. Commencement

This Control Order commences on 1 July 2019.

3. Definitions

Chinese violet means the weed *Asystasia gangetica* species complex

Control Order has the same meaning as in Part 6 of the Act.

Control measures has the same meaning as in Part 6 of the Act.

Control zone has the same meaning as in Part 6 of the Act.

New infestation has the same meaning as in Part 5 of the Regulation.

The Act means the *Biosecurity Act 2015*.

The Regulation means the *Biosecurity Regulation 2017*.

Note: biosecurity matter, biosecurity risk, carrier, deal, land, local control authority, occupier and weed all have the same meaning as in the Act.

4. Biosecurity Matter and Biosecurity Risk

1) The biosecurity matter to which this Control Order relates is Chinese violet.

2) The biosecurity risk to which this Control Order relates is the biosecurity risk posed or likely to be posed by the spread of the weed Chinese violet.

5. Object of the Control Order

Pursuant to section 62(3) of the Act, the object of this control order is to eliminate the weed Chinese violet by eradicating infestations of Chinese violet from the Control zone and preventing any new introductions of Chinese violet into the Control zone

6. Control zone

1) Pursuant to sections 62(1)(a) and 67 of the Act, the control zone to which control measures are required to be implemented under this Control Order is the whole of New South Wales.

2) The control zone is called the Chinese violet Control Zone.

7. Control measures for owners and occupiers of land

Pursuant to section 62(1)(b) of the Act, an owner or occupier of land in the Chinese violet Control Zone on which there is Chinese violet must:

- (a) notify the local control authority for the area if the Chinese violet is part of a new infestation on the land:
 - i) as soon as practicable after becoming aware of the new infestation;
 - ii) verbally or in writing;
 - iii) giving the following:
 - (1) the person's full name and contact details including telephone number;
 - (2) the location of the Chinese violet, including the address and a description of the distribution of the weed at that address
 - (3) any other information reasonably requested by the local control authority; and
- (b) destroy all Chinese violet on the land;
- (c) ensure that subsequent generations of Chinese violet are destroyed; and
- (d) keep the land free of Chinese violet.
- (e) The owner or occupier does not need to comply with (a) above if they know that notification of the infestation on the land has already been given to the local control authority for the area.

8. Control measures for persons dealing with carriers

Pursuant to section 62(1)(b) of the Act, a person who deals with a carrier of Chinese violet in the Chinese violet Control Zone, in circumstances where the person knows or ought reasonably to know of the presence of Chinese violet on the land or in or on the carrier, must:

- (a) ensure that Chinese violet (including any seed and propagules) or matter suspected to be or contain Chinese Violet (including any suspected seeds and propagules) is not moved from the land; and
- (b) immediately notify the local control authority for the area:
 - i) as soon as practicable after becoming aware of the presence of Chinese violet;
 - ii) verbally or in writing;
 - iii) giving the following:
 - (1) the person's full name and contact details including telephone number;
 - (2) the location of the Chinese violet, including the address and a description of the distribution of the weed at that address (if this is known); and
 - iv) any other information reasonably requested by the local control authority.
- (c) The person who deals with a carrier of Chinese violet does not need to comply with (b) above if they know that notification of the infestation on the land has already been given to the local control authority for the area.

9. The persons or class of persons to whom the control measures apply
