REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

**Location**

Lachlan River, Wyangala Dam – adjacent to Wyangala Waters Inland Waters Holiday Park.

**Duration**

8:00am to 6:00pm on the following dates:

- Saturday 17 October 2020
- Sunday 18 October 2020
- Saturday 14 November 2020
- Sunday 15 November 2020
- Saturday 5 December 2020
- Sunday 6 December 2020

**Detail**

A number of competitive water ski races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Wyangala Dam at the location specified above, on the above dates. This will involve the use of high speed power vessels, persons being towed at speed using towlines and persons in the water from time to time, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be marked by inflatable buoys and monitored by control vessels stationed on the boundary.


Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.

### **Detail**

Water ski shows and fireworks events will be conducted on the waters of Lake Mulwala at the Lake Mulwala Water ski Club Lagoon at the above mentioned dates and times.

The events will involve the use of powered vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow lines and the possibility of persons in the water from time to time, presenting a potential hazard to other water ways users.

Fireworks displays staged from land will also occur at the conclusion of events on days other than those detailed above of duration between the hours of 1:00pm to 8:00pm, and Friday 11 December 2020 and Sunday 21 March 2021.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the events and will comprise the waters of Lake Mulwala in the 4 knot zone of the Mulwala Ski Club lagoon, opposite the Mulwala Ski Club and Caravan Park.

The Zone will be monitored by control vessels to advise vessel operators of the closure, and temporary buoyage may be placed to mark the zone depending on the event, and signage will be located at the Mulwala Ski Club boat ramp and foreshore.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone which will be patrolled by control vessels at the entrance to the lagoon.
