Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to place a temporary embargo on any applications for water supply work approvals of the type specified in Schedule 1, within the water sources within the Central Coast Water Management Area specified in Schedule 2.

CENTRAL COAST WATER MANAGEMENT AREA EMBARGO ORDER 2020

under section 110 of the

WATER MANAGEMENT ACT 2000

1 Name of order

This Order is the *Central Coast Water Management Area Embargo Order 2020*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is published in the NSW Government Gazette and remains in force until revoked or until 2 years from the date on which it commences, whichever is sooner.

3 Embargo on applications for water supply work approvals

This Order places an embargo on any applications for water supply work approvals of the type specified in Schedule 1 within the water sources within the Central Coast Water Management Area specified in Schedule 2.

Schedule 1 Water supply work approvals

Water supply work approvals for in-river dams, being dams located on or in a river.

Schedule 2 Water sources to which this Order applies

The following water sources within the Central Coast Water Management Area as defined in subclause 4(1) the *Water Sharing Plan for the Central Coast Unregulated Water Sources 2009*:

- 1 Jiliby Jiliby Creek Water Source; and
- 2 Ourimbah Creek Water Source.
