LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1993

Section 566(3)

NOTICE

Maximum interest on overdue rates and charges

Under delegation from the Minister administering the *Local Government Act 1993*, I specify, pursuant to section 566(3) of that Act, that the maximum rate of interest that may be set by a council in respect of rates and charges that remain unpaid after they become due and payable shall be-

- 0% per annum for the period 1 July 2020 to 31 December 2020 (inclusive); and
- 7% per annum for the period 1 January 2021 to 30 June 2021 (inclusive).

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1993

Section 516(1A)

ORDER

Maximum tariff for purposes of the definition of boarding house and lodging house

Under delegation from the Minister administering the *Local Government Act 1993*, I determine that for the period 1 July 2020 to 30 June 2021 (inclusive) the maximum tariff, exclusive of GST, for a boarding house or lodging house for the purposes of section 516(1A) of that Act is:

- (a) Where full board and lodging is provided-
 - \$397 per week for single accommodation; or
 - \$656 per week for family or shared accommodation.
- (b) Where less than full board and lodging is provided-
 - \$267 per week for single accommodation; or
 - \$441 per week for family or shared accommodation.
