REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Hunter River - adjacent to the Endeavour Rowing Club at Berry Park.

Duration

7:30am to 5:00pm on the following days:

- Saturday 26 September 2020
- Sunday 27 September 2020
- Saturday 24 October 2020
- Sunday 25 October 2020
- Saturday 7 November 2020
- Saturday 20 February 2021
- Sunday 21 February 2021

Detail

Rowing Regattas will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Hunter River at the location specified above, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the events, which will be marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.

Transit lane

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the course during breaks in the racing via a 'transit lane'.

SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS apply to vessels using the transit lane. Pursuant to section 12(3) vessels navigating through the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots and must produce no wash.

Penalties may apply (Section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)
