NATIONAL PARKS AND WILDLIFE ACT 1974

Declaration under section 188H of land as an asset of intergenerational significance for Wollemi pine
(*Wollemia nobilis*)

I hereby declare the land containing and immediately surrounding the population of the Wollemi pine (*Wollemia nobilis*) in Wollemi National Park as an environmental asset of intergenerational significance ('declared land'). The declared land applies to about 5,000 hectares around the population of Wollemi pine (*Wollemia nobilis*) within the 501,703 hectare Wollemi National Park.

This constitutes notice of the declaration under section 188H.
