ABORIGINAL LAND RIGHTS ACT 1983

NOTICE

*I, the Honourable Don Harwin, Minister for Aboriginal Affairs, following approval by the New South Wales Aboriginal Land Council (NSWALC), do, by this notice pursuant to section 231(2) of the Aboriginal Land Rights Act 1983 (the ALRA), extend the appointment of Mr David Morgan as Administrator to the Tweed-Byron Local Aboriginal Land Council for a period of two (2) calendar months, from 9 January 2021. During the period of his appointment, the Administrator will have the specific functions of the Tweed-Byron Local Aboriginal Land Council and any other duties as specified by the instrument of appointment. The Administrator's remuneration and expenses are not to exceed \$21,000 plus GST without the prior approval of NSWALC. The Administrator's remuneration may include fees payable for the services of other personnel within the Administrator's firm who provide services as agents of the Administrator.*

ABORIGINAL LAND RIGHTS ACT 1983

NOTICE

*I, the Honourable Don Harwin, Minister for Aboriginal Affairs, following approval by the New South Wales Aboriginal Land Council (NSWALC), do, by this notice pursuant to section 231(2) of the Aboriginal Land Rights Act 1983 (the ALRA), extend the appointment of Mr Timothy Gumbleton as Administrator to the Condobolin Local Aboriginal Land Council for a period of two (2) calendar months from 28 December 2020. During the period of his appointment, the Administrator will have all of the functions of the Condobolin Local Aboriginal Land Council and any other duties as specified by the instrument of appointment. The Administrator's remuneration and expenses are not to exceed \$27,000 plus GST without the prior approval of NSWALC. The Administrator's remuneration may include fees payable for the services of other personnel within the Administrator's firm who provide services as agents of the Administrator.*
