# Public Health (COVID-19 General) Amendment Order (No 5) 2021

## Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to prohibit the provision, display or production of information or evidence purporting to show a person is a fully vaccinated person, unless it is true and accurate.

## **Public Health (COVID-19 General) Amendment Order (No 5) 2021**

under the

Public Health Act 2010

### **1 Name of Order**

This Order is the *Public Health (COVID-19 General) Amendment Order (No 5) 2021*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Order commences at the beginning of 27 October 2021.

### **3 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order 2021**

#### **Clause 6.4 Information provided under Order must be true and accurate**

Insert after clause 6.4(2)—

- (3) A person must not provide, display or produce to another person information or evidence, including vaccination evidence, purporting to show the person is a fully vaccinated person, unless the information or evidence is true and accurate.
