Lake Albert, Wagga Wagga – all navigable waters

Duration

- 8:00am to 6:00pm – Saturday 13 November 2021
- 8:00am to 6:00pm – Sunday 14 November 2021

Detail

Powerboat demonstrations will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Albert, involving the use of high speed power vessels which will be active in the area during the above times.

Support vessels will be present to manage the event. Participating vessels will operate at high speed, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the entirety of Lake Albert, which will effectively close the Lake to all other vessel use between the above times for this event.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone which will be patrolled by TfNSW Maritime officers.

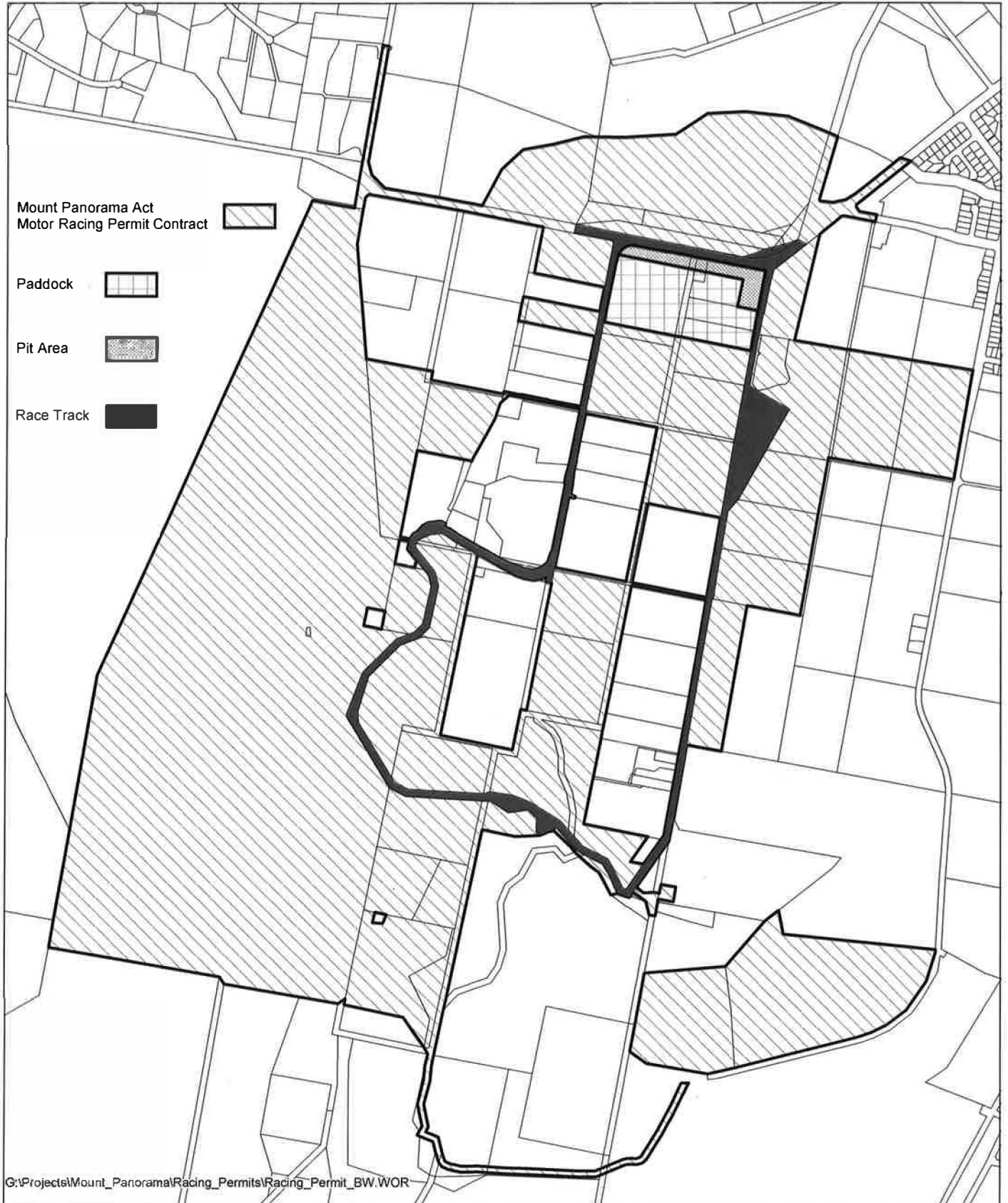
