ACTS OF PARLIAMENT ASSENTED TO Legislative Assembly Office, Sydney 18 November 2021

It is hereby notified, for general information, that Her Excellency the Governor, has, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, this day assented to the under mentioned Acts passed by the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, viz.:

Act No. 28 — An Act to amend the Civil Liability Act 2002 to enable courts to set aside certain agreements that settled claims for child abuse where it is just and reasonable to do so and to ensure that Part 2A of that Act does not restrict awards of damages for child abuse. [Civil Liability Amendment (Child Abuse) Bill]

Act No. 29 — An Act to amend the Payroll Tax Act 2007 to provide for a waiver of payroll tax of 50% for certain employers. [Payroll Tax Amendment (Payroll Tax Waiver) Bill]

Act No. 30 — An Act to amend the Children's Guardian Act 2019 to embed the Child Safe Standards as the primary framework that guides child safe practice in organisations in New South Wales; and for related purposes. [Children's Guardian Amendment (Child Safe Scheme) Bill]
