# Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order (No 4) Amendment (No 1) Order 2021

under the

Public Health Act 2010

## Explanatory note

This Order amends the *Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order (No 4) Order 2021*—

- (a) to specify that a person is **medically cleared** if the person—
  - (i) is diagnosed with COVID-19, and
  - (ii) undergoes a period of self isolation, and
  - (iii) is notified by NSW Health or a medical practitioner that the person may stop self isolating, and
- (b) to omit a redundant provision.

### **1 Name of Order**

This Order is the *Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order (No 4) Amendment (No 1) Order 2021*.

### **2 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order (No 4) Order 2021**

(1) **Clause 10 Responding to police requests about persons in COVID-19 risk premises**

Omit the clause.

(2) **Schedule 1 Dictionary**

Omit the definition of *medically cleared*. Insert instead—

*medically cleared*, in relation to a person diagnosed with COVID-19, means the person has been notified that the person may stop self-isolating—

- (a) by or on behalf of NSW Health, or
- (b) by a medical practitioner.
