**PASSENGER SERVICE CONTRACT EXEMPTION ORDER (BATTERY-ELECTRIC
FERRY TRIAL IN DARLING HARBOUR) 2021**

Explanatory note

The object of this Exemption Order is to enable a Battery-Electric Ferry trial in Darling Harbour, to be operated without a passenger service contract under the *Passenger Transport Act 2014*.

This Order does not authorise wharf access. Arrangements for wharf access are the responsibility of a service operator.

This Order is made under section 39(4) of the *Passenger Transport Act 2014*.

**PASSENGER SERVICE CONTRACT EXEMPTION ORDER (BATTERY-ELECTRIC
FERRY TRIAL IN DARLING HARBOUR) 2021**

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Passenger Service Contract Exemption Order (Battery-Electric Ferry Trial in Darling Harbour) 2021*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on 13 August 2021 and is required to be published in the Gazette.

3 Expiry

This Order expires on 31 July 2022 unless revoked earlier. This Order may be revoked at any time by Transport for NSW.

4 Definitions

In this Order:

Trial Area is the body of water within Darling Harbour bounded to the north by a line between Ballarat Park (Pyrmont) and Watermans Cove (Barangaroo), and including Pyrmont Bay and Cockle Bay.

Trial Ferry means the vessels named Barangaroo (UVI 446139) and Wallaru (UVI 449265).

5 Exemption

A public passenger service by vessel conducted according to regular routes and timetables or according to regular routes and at regular intervals is exempted from the requirement to be operated under the authority of a passenger service contract under section 39 of the *Passenger Transport Act 2014* to the extent that the service is operated within the Trial Area by a Trial Ferry.
