### **2 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021**

#### **Clause 4.2 Staying at home**

Omit clause 4.2(2). Insert instead—

- (2) A reasonable excuse includes an activity specified for an area of concern in Schedule 2.
