- (a) to defer the repeal of the stay at home areas and areas of concern until 11 October 2021, and
- (b) to retain the local government area of Cowra in the regional NSW stay at home area until 5 October 2021.

### **2 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021**

#### **(1) Clause 7.5 Repeal**

Omit “1 October 2021”. Insert instead “11 October 2021”.

#### **(2) Schedule 1 Categories of area**

Omit “28 September 2021” from clause 3, table, item 7.

Insert instead “5 October 2021”.
