1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Public Health Repeal Order 2022*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences at the beginning of 14 October 2022.

3 Repeals

- (1) The following are repealed—
 - (a) *Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order (No 3) 2022*,
 - (b) *Public Health (COVID-19 General) Order (No 3) 2022*.
- (2) This Order is repealed at the beginning of 15 October 2022.
