ACTS OF PARLIAMENT ASSENTED TO Legislative Assembly Office, Sydney 26 October 2022

It is hereby notified, for general information, that Her Excellency the Governor, has, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, this day assented to the under mentioned Acts passed by the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, viz.:

Act No. 54 — An Act to provide for financial assistance for the purposes of the provision of affordable and accessible childcare. [Childcare and Economic Opportunity Fund Bill]

Act No. 55 — An Act to amend the *Confiscation of Proceeds of Crime Act 1989*, the *Crime Commission Act 2012* and the *Criminal Assets Recovery Act 1990*, including to implement recommendations resulting from the statutory review of the *Crime Commission Act 2012* and the *Criminal Assets Recovery Act 1990*. [Confiscation of Proceeds of Crime Legislation Amendment Bill]

Act No. 56 — An Act to amend the *Constitution Act 1902* to clarify that the appointment of persons to the offices of Lieutenant-Governor of the State and Administrator of the State is to be made by the Governor of the State. [Constitution Amendment (Appointment of Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator) Bill]

Act No. 57 — An Act to amend electoral legislation to make further provision about the election of members of Parliament, the regulation of political donations and electoral expenditure and the public funding of election campaigns and other activities; and for other purposes. [Electoral Legislation Amendment Bill]

Act No. 58 — An Act to amend electoral legislation to make further provision about postal voting and telephone voting; and for other purposes. [Electoral Legislation Amendment Bill (No 2)]

Act No. 59 — An Act to repeal an Act and instrument and to amend certain other Acts and instruments in various respects and for the purpose of effecting statute law revision; and to make certain savings. [Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Bill (No 2)]
