REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Jervis Bay, Callala Beach – 200 metres from the shoreline between the landmarks of Centre Street and Sir Henry Crescent.

Duration

- 6:30am to 1:30pm – Saturday 17 December 2022

Detail

Swimming legs of a triathlon event will be conducted on the waters of Jervis Bay at the location specified above, which will effectively create a rectangular course approximately 300 metres long extending approximately 200 metres from the shoreline.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be marked by course rounding buoys. The zone will extend for 50 metres outside the course rounding buoys on all sides and will be monitored by authorised vessels stationed on the perimeter.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*).

Detail

Water ski shows will be conducted at the location at the above-mentioned dates and times.

The events will involve the use of powered vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow lines and the possibility of persons in the water from time to time, presenting a potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the events and will comprise the waters of Lake Mulwala within the 4 knot zone in front of the Mulwala Ski Club Holiday Park and the Mulwala Ski Club Lagoon.

The exclusion zone will be indicated by the presence of control vessels, event officials, temporary buoyage (event dependent) and signage located at the Mulwala Ski Club boat ramp and foreshore.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Lake Mulwala – the entirety of the navigable channel between 500 metres upstream and 500 metres downstream of the Majors Creek Boat Ramp, near the township of Mulwala.

Duration

- 7.30am to 6:00pm – Saturday 19 November 2022
- 7.30am to 6:00pm – Sunday 20 November 2022

Detail

A wakeboarding competition will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Mulwala as specified above. There will be support vessels present to manage the event, persons in the water from time to time, and persons being towed at speed using tow-lines – presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event which will comprise the entirety of the navigable channel at the location detailed above.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone, which will be marked by buoys and monitored and maintained by control vessels.

At various times during the event, control vessels may authorise local vessel traffic to transit the zone.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998)

Manning River, between Martin Bridge and the Eastern end of Dumaresq Island.

Duration

7.00am to 1.00pm – 5 November 2022

7.00am to 1.00pm – 6 November 2022

Detail

Rowing Regattas will be conducted on the Manning River, between Martin Bridge and the Eastern end of Dumaresq Island at the above times.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified at the above location while the events are in progress.

On Saturday 5 November 2022 the Zone will consist of a 900m course from the Martin Bridge to the Manning River Rowing Club and will be marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels.

On Sunday 6 November 2022 the Zone will be around Dumaresq Island from a start and finish at the Endeavour Place boat ramp, Taree and will be indicated and monitored by the presence of control vessels on the perimeters.

Provision has been made for vessels to transit the Zone during breaks in the racing. Control vessels will, at times during the event, authorise local vessel traffic to transit the Zone.


Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the times above.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Location

Lake Mulwala – near the locality of the Mulwala Water Ski Club and within an area bounded by:

1. The Mulwala foreshore between the entrance of the Mulwala Canal and south to the Melbourne Street Bridge, then
2. East into Lake Mulwala for a distance of approximately 750 metres, then
3. North for a distance of approximately 2.5km to a location directly east of the entrance of the Mulwala Canal, then
4. West to the entrance of the Mulwala Canal.

Duration

- 7.30am to 5.00pm - Saturday 19 and Sunday 20 November 2022

Detail

Water Ski Races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Mulwala, Mulwala as specified above. This will involve the use of powered vessels, persons being towed at speed using tow lines and the possibility of persons in the water from time to time, presenting a potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event at the location specified above, which will be marked by buoys and be monitored and maintained control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the exclusion zone.

TRANSIT LANE AND SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

A 'transit lane' will be established along the foreshore from the Lake Mulwala Holiday Park, south of the Mulwala Water Ski Club, to the Melbourne Street bridge, Mulwala, within which an authorised control vessel may, at times during the event, authorise local vessel traffic to pass through and within the confines of the transit lane.

SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS apply to vessels using the transit lane. Vessels navigating the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots and must produce no wash.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)

Location

Wallis Lake, Forster – between Kenrose Canal and Supply Avenue, adjacent to Elizabeth Parade

Duration

8.00am to 5.00pm on the following dates:

- Sunday 19 and Sunday 20 November 2022

Detail

Dragon Boat Races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Wallis Lake, Forster specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event which will be marked by the presence of control vessels on the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone.

Transit lane

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the Exclusion Zone via a 'transit lane'.

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, all vessels using the transit lane:

- Must not exceed the maximum speed limit of 4 knots, and
- Must produce minimal wash.
