NOTICE OF RESERVATION OF A NATIONAL PARK

I, the Honourable Margaret Beazley AC KC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, reserve the land described in the Schedule below under the provisions of Section 30A(1)(a) of the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974* and under Section 30A(2) assign the name **Brindingabba National Park**.


