Energy and Utilities Administration (Declaration of Coal Market Price Emergency) Order 2022

under the

Energy and Utilities Administration Act 1987

I, Dominic Perrottet MP, Premier of the State of New South Wales, declare a coal market price emergency under the *Energy and Utilities Administration Act 1987*, Schedule 3, clause 3, being satisfied this declaration is necessary to reduce the risk that increases in coal prices will adversely affect members of the community by contributing, or potentially contributing, to an increase in electricity prices.

The declaration of a coal market price emergency takes effect when this order is made.

This order remains in force from when it is made until the beginning of 30 June 2024, unless sooner revoked.
